STOCKS

Singapore shares end flattish amid mixed regional showing; STI up 0.02%

Across the broader market, gainers outnumber losers 315 to 285 after 1.8b securities worth S\$2.6b change hands. BY EVAN SEE

SINGAPORE stocks were flattish on Thursday (May 21) amid a mixed performance in regional markets.

The benchmark Straits Times Index (STI) gained 0.02 per cent or 0.80 point to finish at 5,045.71.

Venture Corporation led the gainers on Singapore's blue-chip index, rising 2.5 per cent or S\$0.43 to end at S\$17.65.

The worst performer among STI constituents was Singtel, which fell 6.4 per cent or S\$0.32 to close at S\$4.70.

The telco earlier on Thursday posted a net profit of S\$2.2 billion for the six months ended Mar 31, down 20.9 per cent from the year-ago period.

The three local banks ended Thursday higher. DBS gained 0.7 per cent or S\$0.45 to S\$61.75, OCBC rose 0.4 per cent or S\$0.09 to S\$23.33, and UOB

was up 0.3 per cent or S\$0.10 at S\$37.69.

Across the broader market, gainers outnumbered losers 315 to 285 after 1.8 billion securities worth S\$2.6 billion changed hands.

Within the iEdge Singapore Next 50 Index, UltraGreen.AI was the top gainer, rising 8.3 per cent or US\$0.10 to US\$1.30. First Resources was the index's biggest decliner, falling 5.6 per cent or S\$0.17 to end the session at S\$2.86.

Key regional indices were mixed. Japan's Nikkei 225 rose 3.1 per cent, and South Korea's Kospi was up 8.4 per cent. Meanwhile, Hong Kong's Hang Seng Index lost 1 per cent, and the FTSE Bursa Malaysia KLCI declined 0.5 per cent.

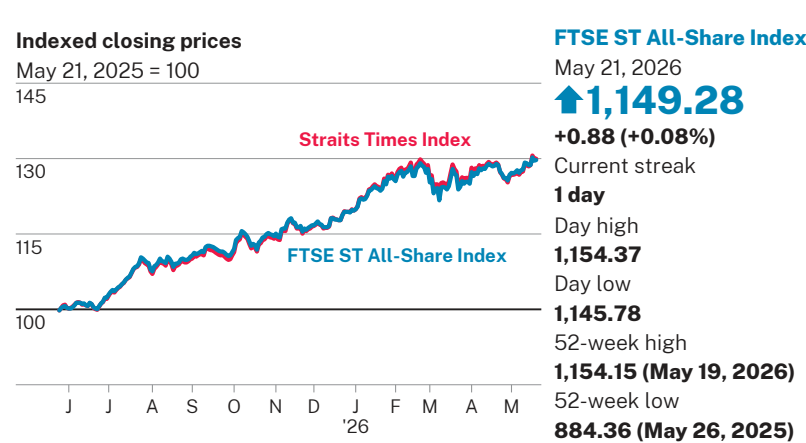

Greenback edges up; euro and sterling slip

THE US dollar firmed on Thursday (May 21) – but stayed below a six-week peak – as hopes that Washington was nearing a deal with Teheran to end the war in the Middle East capped further rises.

US President Donald Trump said on Wednesday that negotiations with Teheran were in the final stages, while also warning of further attacks if Iran does not agree to a deal.

The greenback firmed 0.1 per cent against the yen to 159.060 yen after falling for the first time in eight sessions against the Japanese currency on Wednesday.

Bank of Japan policy board member Junko Koeda added a measure of support for the yen with hawkish comments on Thursday, saying in a speech that the central bank needs to continue to

raise rates with underlying inflation already around a 2 per cent target.

The euro was 0.2 per cent down at US\$1.160050, after dipping on Wednesday to its weakest level since Apr 7 at US\$1.1583 before bouncing back. The euro dipped after French purchasing managers' indices (PMIs) for May showed the economy contracting at its sharpest pace in 5.5 years.

"Terrible French PMI... but (the) ECB (European Central Bank) seems determined to raise rates," said Kenneth Broux, head of corporate research FX and rates at Societe Generale, in explaining the negative euro.

Sterling was down 0.1 per cent at US\$1.3421. The dollar index, which measures the greenback against the euro, yen and four other rivals,



rose 0.2 per cent to 99.295, down from a peak of 99.472 on Wednesday, the strongest level since Apr 7.

"The 'safe haven' flows reversed because of positive news about the Iran war," said Joseph Capurso, head of FX at Commonwealth Bank

of Australia. At the same time, while the US has "domestic political incentives to seek peace, we would not be surprised if President Trump chooses military escalation to gain leverage in negotiations", he added.

Market focus has been on the potential inflationary impact of higher energy prices as the Strait of Hormuz remains largely closed to shipping.

In a note, Commerzbank FX analysts said that many central banks may label the inflation shock as transitory should the strait open in the next few days, but this would be incorrect as it does not take into account loss of purchasing power.

"Consequently, currencies are likely to benefit in countries where the central bank is slower to speak of transitory price spikes but may nevertheless tighten monetary

policy," they added.

Notes from the Federal Reserve's April meeting, published on Wednesday, revealed officials' intensifying concerns about inflation, with a growing number open to the possibility that they may need to raise interest rates.

Elsewhere, the Australian dollar declined following a surprise rise in the unemployment rate to the highest since 2021, which reduced the case for higher interest rates. The Aussie slipped 0.55 per cent to US\$0.71105 as traders pared back bets for Reserve Bank of Australia (RBA) tightening this year.

"Our call for the RBA to pause in its June policy meeting is now high-conviction," Westpac economist Ryan Wells said. "Still, the most immediate and pressing concern for the RBA is inflation. We continue to expect that the RBA will resume raising the cash rate when the size and pace of pass-through of the energy price shock is revealed." REUTERS
