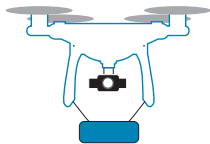


Driving it home

SingPost successfully completed a trial in September last year where an unmanned aerial vehicle drops off mail or a parcel. No time frame given on when the service will be launched commercially.

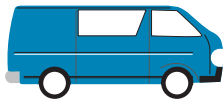
POP Station
