TYPE	DESCRIPTION	DESTINATIONS
Reciprocal green lanes/fast lanes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ For short-term essential travel such as business or official travel ■ Stringent requirements such as travellers have to undergo pre-departure and post-arrival Covid tests, stick to a controlled itinerary, and use the TraceTogether app while in Singapore ■ No quarantine but will need to self isolate while waiting for test results 	Brunei, China (Shanghai, Tianjin, Chongqing, Guangdong, Jiangsu and Zhejiang), Japan, Indonesia, Malaysia*, South Korea
Periodic Commuting Arrangement (PCA)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ For longer term work/business travel ■ Allows Singapore and Malaysia residents with valid work passes to enter for work ■ Travellers to Singapore under the PCA scheme have to serve a Stay-Home Notice (SHN) period and undergo a Covid-19 test before the 7-day SHN period ends ■ After at least 90 days in their country of work, they can return to their home country for short-term leave and may re-enter their country of work for at least another 90 days 	Malaysia*
Unilateral	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Visitors need an Air Travel Pass which enables short term travel, including leisure travel ■ Upon arrival, a swab test is required and visitors need to produce a negative result before they can carry on ■ No quarantine 	Australia (except Victoria state), Brunei, New Zealand, Vietnam

*Travellers who have been to Sabah recently have to serve a 14 day SHN at a SHN facility
