


State funeral procession



1 Parliament House
The procession will begin here at 2pm and pass through landmarks of significance to Mr Nathan.

2 City Hall
Mr Nathan reviewed the National Day Parade here in 2000, 2005 and 2010. In office, he founded the President's Challenge, which raised over S\$100 million for more than 500 beneficiary organisations.

3 Fullerton Hotel
Early in his public service career, Mr Nathan was appointed as a seamen's welfare officer at the Marine Department, located at the Fullerton Building, now known as the Fullerton Hotel. This marked the beginning of his career in labour relations and diplomacy.

4 NTUC Centre
Between 1962 and 1965, Mr Nathan served in the Labour Research Unit, a unit of the National Trades Union Congress. He helped the labour movement overcome the challenge posed by pro-communist unions to eventually become the country's main trade union movement.

5 University Cultural Centre
A state funeral service for Mr Nathan will be held at 3pm at the National University of Singapore's University Cultural Centre.
