## Singapore shares rally; STI up 1%

Jardine Matheson and Yangzijiang Shipbuilding lead the gainers on the blue-chip index, both rising 4.3%

SINGAPORE stocks ended higher on Monday (Jun 15).

The benchmark Straits Times Index (STI) gained 1 per cent or 51.49 points to finish at 5,077.29.

Jardine Matheson and Yangzijiang Shipbuilding led the gainers on Singapore's blue-chip index, both rising 4.3 per cent.

Jardine Matheson ended at US\$66, up US\$2.75, and Yangzijiang Shipbuilding closed at S\$3.60, up S\$0.15.

The worst performer among STI constituents was Keppel DC Real Estate Investment Trust, which fell 1.3 per cent or S\$0.03 to close at S\$2.26.

The three local banks ended higher.

DBS gained 0.4 per cent or S\$0.25 to S\$63.49, OCBC rose 0.9 per cent or S\$0.21 to S\$23.71, and UOB was up 0.8 per cent or S\$0.29 at S\$38.45.

Within the iEdge Singapore Next 50 Index, UMS Integration was the

top gainer, rising 10.3 per cent or S\$0.26 to finish at S\$2.78.

Riverstone was the biggest loser, falling 2.3 per cent or S\$0.02 to end the session at S\$0.845.

Across the broader market, gainers beat losers 435 to 196, after 1.5 billion securities worth S\$2.1 billion changed hands.

Key regional indices were all positive.

Hong Kong's Hang Seng Index gained 0.5 per cent, Japan's Nikkei 225 index rose 5 per cent, South Korea's Kospi was up 5.2 per cent and the FTSE Bursa Malaysia KLCI ad-

vanced 0.5 per cent.

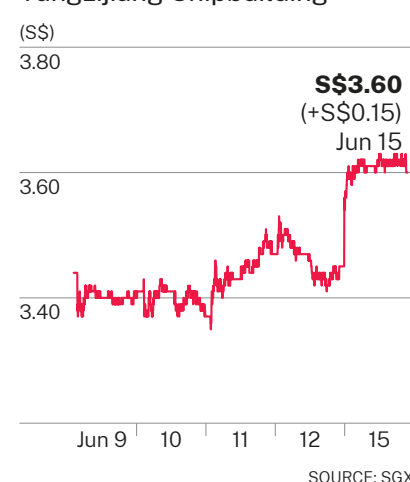
The local market's rally comes after a 0.8 per cent increase on Friday, and follows confirmation that a formal peace treaty between the US and Iran will be signed on Jun 19 in Switzerland.

"The ceasefire is a net positive for the (Singapore) market but largely priced in," said Glenn Thum, research manager at Phillip Securities Research.

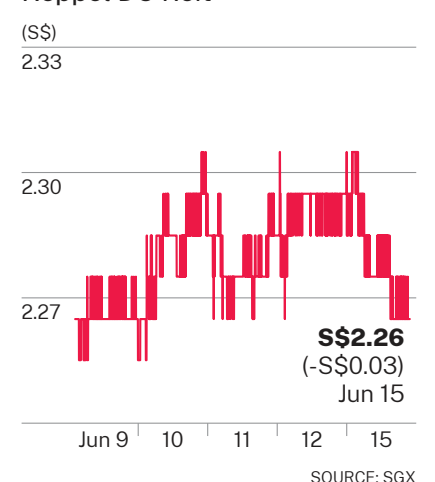
## Top gainer

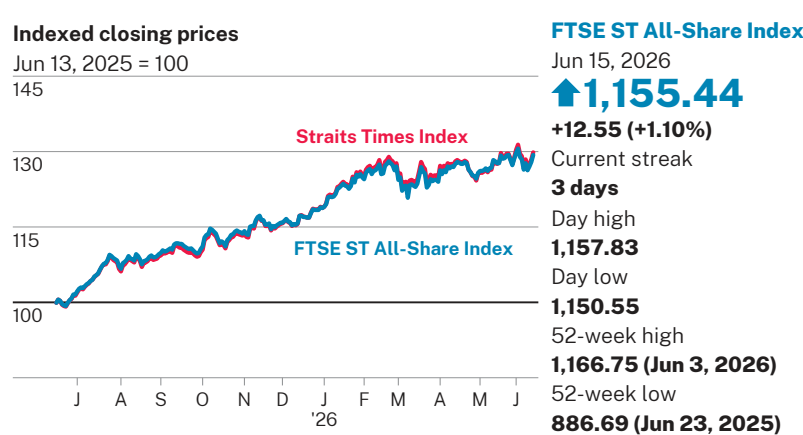

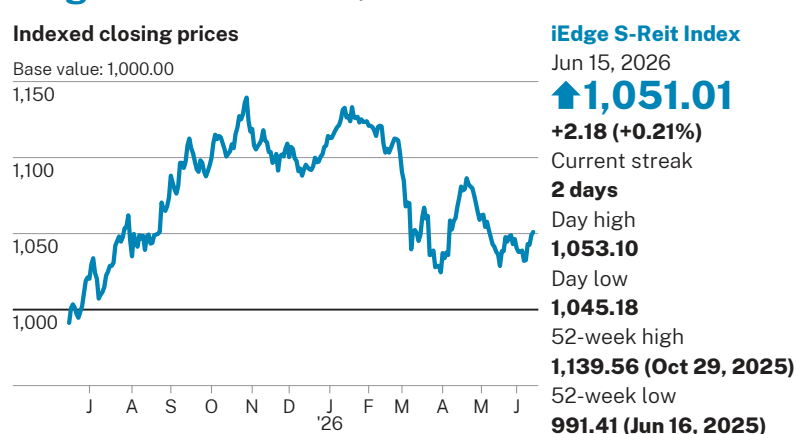

# Greenback near 10-day low as US, Iran reach peace deal

THE US dollar hovered near a 10-day low against other major currencies on Monday (Jun 15) as a preliminary agreement to end the war between the US and Iran sent oil prices tumbling and lifted risk sentiment.

US and Iranian officials said on Sunday that they had agreed on a framework for a deal to end their war, halt the US blockade of Iran and reopen the Strait of Hormuz.

The memorandum of understanding is scheduled to be officially signed on Friday in Switzerland, but caution still lingered as markets awaited more details and as the fate of Iran's nuclear programme was left for further negotiations.

Oil prices slumped, with Brent crude futures down around 5 per cent to US\$82.90 a barrel.

The dollar index, which measures the greenback against a basket

cially, we haven't heard anything on the nuclear side. If that comes through over the next few days, then I think we can be a bit more constructive."

"But without a nuclear agreement, I don't think we can simply assume that any deal's going to hold. So we are cautiously optimistic, but that warrants a relatively small FX reaction," Rees added.

The euro was last 0.36 per cent higher at US\$1.1610, and the sterling rose 0.15 per cent to US\$1.3423. Both were near their strongest levels since June 5.

The Japanese yen was broadly steady at 160.13 per dollar, continuing to hold around the 160-level,

widely seen as a line in the sand for potential official intervention.

**Central banks in focus**

Major central banks, including the US Federal Reserve, the Bank of Japan, the Bank of England and the Reserve Bank of Australia, will deliver rate decisions this week, with markets focused on whether prospects for a peace deal will ease their inflation concerns and influence the current tightening trajectory.

The Federal Reserve is widely expected to hold rates in the current range of 3.5 to 3.75 per cent on Wednesday, but all eyes will be on the policy statement and press conference for what the new chair, Kevin Warsh, signals.

Investors trimmed bets on a rate hike this year and now price in a roughly 50 per cent chance of a

move in December, down from over 70 per cent a week ago, according to the CME FedWatch Tool.

"Negotiations on aspects of the deal are ongoing, but no doubt central bankers will be breathing a sigh of relief, for now at least, that the upside risks to inflation appear to be receding and not becoming the central scenario," said Prashant Newnaha, senior rates strategist at TD Securities in Singapore.

The Bank of Japan is set to raise interest rates to 1 per cent, a 31-year high, at its two-day meeting concluding on Tuesday. It is also expected to signal readiness to keep pushing up borrowing costs to combat inflation risks despite the peace deal.

Meanwhile, both the Reserve Bank of Australia and the Bank of England are expected to hold rates steady. REUTERS
