Trump-Xi meeting fails to lift Singapore shares; STI dips 0.2%

Across the broader market, gainers trail losers 257 to 359, after 2.2b securities worth S\$2.6b change hands. **BY JUDE CHAN**

SINGAPORE stocks ended lower on Thursday (May 14), as a much-anticipated meeting between Chinese leader Xi Jinping and US President Donald Trump failed to lift investor sentiment.

The benchmark Straits Times Index (STI) lost 0.2 per cent or 8.02 points to finish at 4,995.94.

Across the broader market, losers outpaced gainers 359 to 257, after 2.2 billion securities worth S\$2.6 billion changed hands.

Singtel led the gainers on Singapore's blue-chip index, rising 1 per cent or S\$0.05 to S\$4.87.

The worst performer among the STI constituents was Frasers Logistics & Commercial Trust, which fell 3.6 per cent or S\$0.035 to S\$0.94.

The three local banks ended high-

er. DBS gained 0.4 per cent or S\$0.23 to close at S\$60.13, OCBC rose 0.3 per cent or S\$0.06 to S\$22.95. UOB was up 0.1 per cent or S\$0.02 to S\$37.37.

Within the iEdge Singapore Next 50 Index, Pan-United Corporation was the top gainer, rising 6.1 per cent or S\$0.10 to S\$1.73. Meanwhile, ComfortDelGro was the top loser, falling 6.3 per cent or S\$0.09 to end the session at S\$1.33.

Key regional indices were mixed. Hong Kong's Hang Seng Index ended largely flat, while Japan's Nikkei 225 index fell 1 per cent, South Korea's Kospi was up 1.8 per cent, and the FTSE Bursa Malaysia KLCI declined 0.04 per cent.

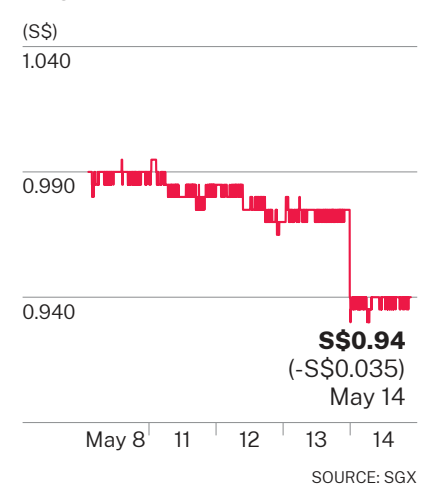

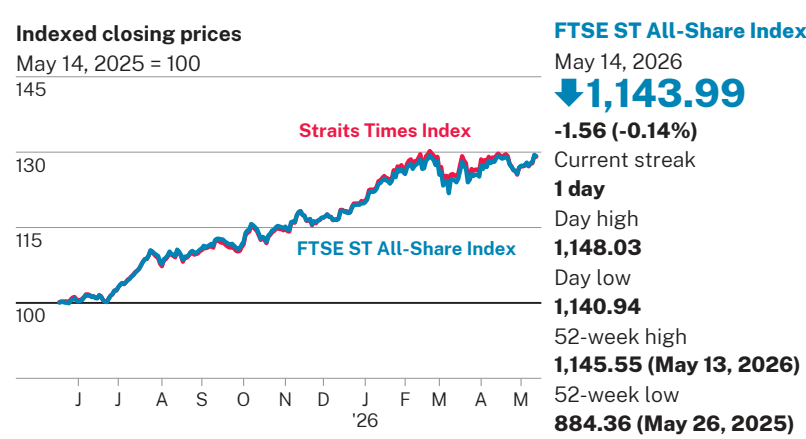

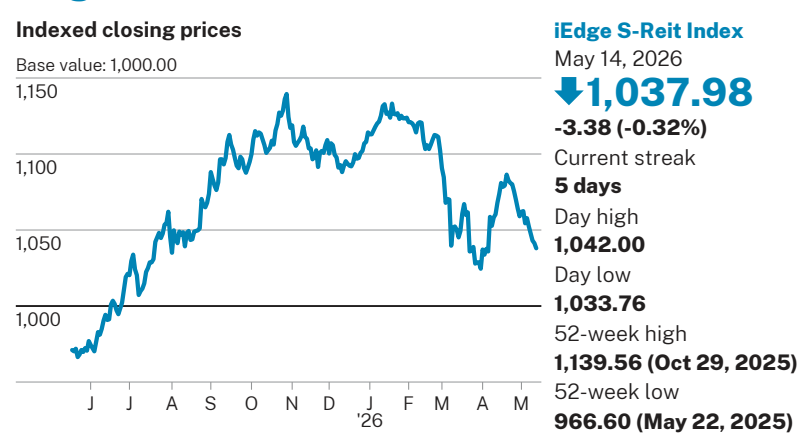

US dollar lifted by growing odds of Fed rate hikes

THE US dollar rose for a fourth day on Thursday (May 14), underpinned by higher US Treasury yields, as investors began to price in the chances of Federal Reserve rate hikes this year, while the global focus was on a two-day summit between US President Donald Trump and China's Xi Jinping.

Xi told Trump trade talks were making progress at the start of a two-day summit on Thursday, but cautioned that disagreement over Taiwan could send relations down a dangerous path and even lead to conflict.

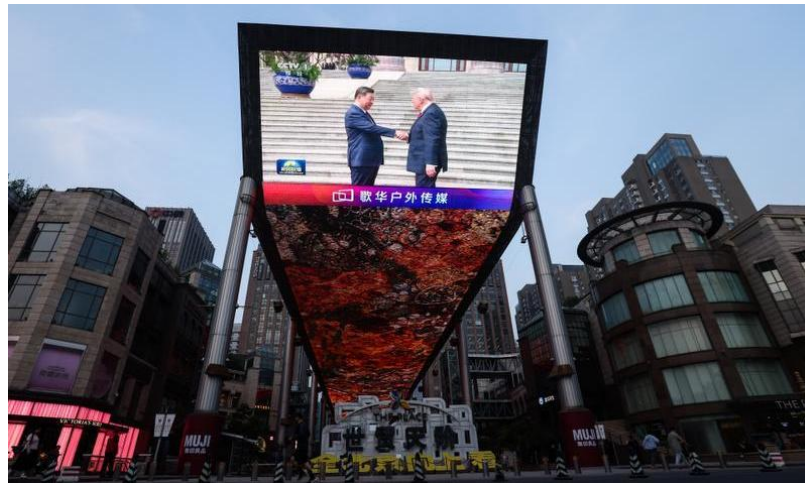
With the summit underway, China's onshore yuan traded around three-year highs. In offshore trading, the currency strengthened for an eighth straight day against the dollar to 6.7844.

In the broader market, the dollar

edged up against other major currencies. The euro was last down 0.1 per cent at US\$1.1701, set for a 0.6 per cent loss this week, which would mark its largest decline in two months.

Against a basket of currencies, the US dollar was last at 98.57, up 0.7 per cent for the week so far and heading for its strongest weekly performance since the start of the Iran war. It reversed early gains against the yen to trade a touch lower at 157.87, as the Japanese currency drew support from comments by Bank of Japan board member Kazuyuki Masu, who said the central bank should move to raise interest rates promptly if there are no clear signs of an economic slowdown.

Japanese authorities are believed to have intervened several



times in the past couple of weeks to temper the dollar's strength, but with traders now pricing in the prospect of the Fed raising rates this year, the yen is flagging. The US currency has now recovered 50

per cent of the losses incurred since officials stepped in to prop up the yen.

The dollar rally has been gathering pace all week, on the back of evidence that domestic inflation is

mounting. The latest data point on Wednesday showed US producer prices posted their biggest increase in four years in April, on the heels of Tuesday's report that showed consumer inflation ran at its fastest pace in three years.

"The inflation data we received this week certainly won't be welcomed by FOMC (Federal Open Market Committee) officials, including incoming Fed chair Kevin Warsh," said Carol Kong, a currency strategist at Commonwealth Bank of Australia.

The US Senate on Wednesday approved Warsh as Fed chair, putting the 56-year-old lawyer and fin-

ancier at the helm of the US central bank. "We forecast that the FOMC will have to start a tightening cycle from December this year, and we forecast three hikes in the cycle for now," said Kong.

Markets are now pricing in a 35 per cent chance that the Fed will raise rates in December, up from just over a 16 per cent chance a week ago, according to LSEG data. The change in rate expectations and fears of a surge in inflation have sent long-dated US Treasury yields to their highest since mid-2025.

Thirty-year bond yields were last down 2.5 basis points on the day at 5.02 per cent. The pound was a touch lower against both the dollar and the euro after data showed UK growth expanded unexpectedly in March. REUTERS
