

Tapping the brakes on Covid-19



Tighter measures from Sept 27 to Oct 24

- Maximum of two people for social gatherings, dining-in groups, daily household visitors
- Work-from-home as default for employees who can do so
- Home-based learning extended through Oct 7



S\$650 million support package

- Jobs Support Scheme support raised to 25 per cent for Sept 27 to Oct 24, for affected sectors including F&B, retail, cinemas
- Two-week rental waiver or rental relief cash payout, respectively, for qualifying tenants or occupiers in government-owned or privately-owned commercial properties
- Covid-19 Driver Relief Fund payout extended for October, November



Expanded care capacity

- Home recovery remains default for eligible fully-vaccinated persons; Singapore Armed Forces, People's Association brought in to help
- More Community Treatment Facilities for at-risk patients who are asymptomatic or mildly symptomatic



Expanded testing access, booster shots

- Eight regional screening centres, three quick test centres to open on weekends
- From Oct 4, booster shots extended to those aged 50 to 59
