Milestones

1891 Set up Singapore's first oil storage

1961 Established the first oil refinery in Singapore in Pulau Bukom

1970s Added investments into a Thermal Gasoil unit and a Single Buoy Mooring System off Bukom, among others

1990s Established chemical plants on Jurong Island

1991 Received the Distinguished Partner in Progress award from the Singapore government

2009 Opened world-scale plant producing monoethylene glycol – used in the production of polyester fibres and film among others – at Jurong Island

2010 Opened the Shell Eastern Petrochemicals Complex, its largest fully-integrated refinery and petrochemicals complex in the world

2011 Marked 120 years in Singapore. Saw one of Singapore's worst industrial fires in history at Pulau Bukom refinery

2013 Moved the global integrated gas business to Singapore, and gave the green light for two new world-scale plants producing high purity ethylene and ethoxylates

2014 Received the Honorary Partner in Progress award from the government
