

# Enhanced circuit breaker measures & support



## ■ The circuit breaker restrictions will be extended to June 1, 2020.

■ The government will provide another S\$3.8 billion to extend to May the **75% wage support for all sectors, the foreign worker levy waiver and rebate**. The wage support **will also cover employees who are shareholders and directors** of the company.

■ **Foreign workers in dormitories are barred from going to work**, including those working in companies previously applied and given exemption.

■ The proportion of workers commuting to work daily **will be cut from 20 to 15 per cent** of the workforce to reduce workers' movements and interactions.

■ The list of **providers of essential services and the numbers of workplaces will be reduced**. Those allowed to

continue must put in place measures to further minimise interactions.

■ **Visitors to four popular markets will be restricted to alternate days based on the last digit of their NRIC numbers**. Those whose NRIC has an even number can only visit the markets on the even dates of the month, while those with an odd number can only visit on the odd dates of the month. The markets are Geylang Serai Market, Chong Pang Market and the markets at Blk 20/21 Marsiling Lane and Blk 505 Jurong West Street 52.

■ **Mid-year school holidays brought forward to May 5; additional 1-week break in July**.

■ Individuals who must leave home to buy food/grocery or to exercise, **should go only alone**.

■ If the local transmission numbers fall significantly to a single-digit number, some of the restrictive measures may gradually be eased.
