Singapore shares retreat as US-Iran strikes unsettle markets; STI down 0.8%

Across the broader market, losers outnumbered gainers 405 to 248, as 2b securities worth S\$2.8b change hands

SINGAPORE stocks finished Thursday (May 28) lower after renewed US military strikes on Iran dampened hopes for a ceasefire in the Gulf, as well as investors' risk appetites.

The benchmark Straits Times Index (STI) lost 0.8 per cent or 39.61 points to close at 4,989.19. Across the broader market, losers outnumbered gainers 405 to 248 after two billion securities worth S\$2.8 billion changed hands.

Sats led the gainers on Singapore's blue-chip index, with a 6.7 per cent or S\$0.24 climb to S\$3.80.

The biggest decliner among the STI constituents was Jardine Matheson, which fell 5.6 per cent or US\$64.20 to US\$64.20.

The local banks all ended lower. DBS slipped 0.1 per cent or S\$0.07 to S\$61.93, OCBC lost 0.9 per cent or S\$0.20 to end at S\$23.16, and UOB was

down 0.1 per cent or S\$0.03 at S\$37.69.

Within the iEdge Singapore Next 50 Index, Golden Agri-Resources was the top gainer. It rose 1.9 per cent or S\$0.005 to S\$0.27.

Meanwhile, First Resources was the biggest decliner, falling 4 per cent or S\$0.11 to end the session at S\$2.67.

Key regional indices ended in the red. Hong Kong's Hang Seng Index lost 1.3 per cent, Japan's Nikkei 225 fell 0.5

per cent, South Korea's Kospi was down 0.5 per cent and the FTSE Bursa Malaysia KLCI declined 0.8 per cent.

Meanwhile, oil advanced, following a drop of more than 5 per cent on Wednesday.

"The oil market remains confused about the ongoing geopolitics," said Norbert Rucker, head of economics and next generation research at Julius Baer.

He noted that hopes for normalisation have given way to fears of escalation, as recent military attacks cast doubt on earlier reports of progress in the negotiation.

"The tug of war between escalation and normalisation keeps the oil market on its toes," he added.

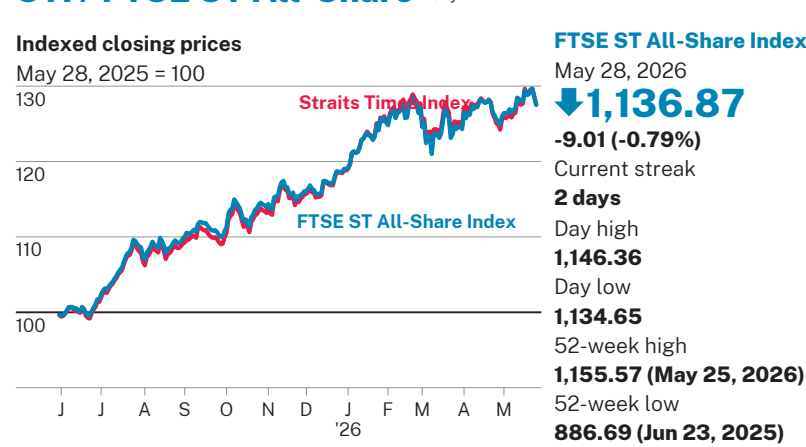

Greenback up amid doubts over Hormuz deal

THE US dollar was higher on Thursday (May 28), just off its strongest level since early April, as doubts grew over prospects of a deal to reopen the Strait of Hormuz and focus shifted to possible US interest rate hikes.

Iran's Revolutionary Guard targeted a US airbase on Thursday, according to an Iranian media report, hours after US President Donald Trump rejected a report he was close to a compromise deal with Tehran.

The dollar surged in March after Iran's effective closure of the Strait of Hormuz sent oil prices soaring, hitting importers such as Japan and the eurozone and boosting safe-haven demand for the greenback. It fell after Trump announced a two-week ceasefire on Apr 7, before recovering in May on growing

doubts about a lasting deal.

Investors are also assessing the Federal Reserve's interest rate outlook ahead of economic data later in the session.

"Given that statements from FOMC (Federal Open Market Committee) members have become increasingly hawkish in recent days and weeks, which is certainly one of the key reasons for the shift in market expectations towards interest rate hikes, it will be decisive whether the figures support these expectations," Commerzbank rate strategist Michael Pfister said.

Governor Christopher Waller said last Friday that the Fed should axe the "easing bias" from its policy statement and effectively open the door to a possible rate hike.

ING analysts recently said the hawkish Fed narrative is likely to



dominate in the coming weeks, warning the euro may struggle to hold above the US\$1.165 to US\$1.166 range. The single currency was down 0.16 per cent at US\$1.1607. Markets will now turn

to the Fed's preferred inflation gauge, the core PCE deflator, due later in the day.

Oil prices rose more than 2 per cent on Thursday after dropping over 5 per cent the previous day, as

Iran's Revolutionary Guards said they targeted a US airbase in response to a US attack in the port city of Bandar Abbas.

The dollar index, a gauge of the greenback's value relative to a basket of major foreign currencies, was up 0.18 per cent at 99.39, after touching 99.546 in Asian trade, its highest since Apr 7.

Analysts at Barclays said that geopolitical tensions and resilient risk sentiment could dampen the usual boost the dollar gets from Fed hikes, as safe-haven demand would fade when the Iran conflict eases.

"The Fed might move towards fulfilling Kevin Warsh's 'dovish' in-

clinations more readily without a war to drive US inflation expectations even higher," Thierry Wizman, global forex and rates strategist at Macquarie Group, said, referring to the impact of a durable 'peace' deal.

Hours after Warsh was sworn in at a White House ceremony, Trump said he expected rates to come down. Analysts said a sharp rebound in the yen from current weak levels is unlikely, with a June Bank of Japan rate hike largely priced in. The threat of official intervention could limit losses past 160 per dollar. The dollar was little changed against the yen at 159.43.

US data will remain key, as a more hawkish Fed could limit any pullback in dollar-yen, with short-term US-Japan yield spreads still the main driver. REUTERS
