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# LAGUNA NATIONAL LAUNCHES NEW CLUBHOUSE

MODERN BUILDING IS PART OF THE GOLF CLUB'S MULTI-MILLION DOLLAR TRANSFORMATION

After three years of development, members and guests of Laguna National Golf & Country Club can finally look forward to a brand new clubhouse experience.

The clubhouse is part of a larger complex that will house a 198-room luxury resort, the Dusit Thani Laguna Singapore, which will be the hotel chain's first international property and is expected to officially open in December.

Upon arrival at the clubhouse, golfers are welcomed to The Shop; a 312-square-metre pro shop that is the largest of its kind in Singapore.

The new Golfer's Lounge provides panoramic views of the Masters Course as players wait for their tee-off time, or regroup after a round.

## DINING OPTIONS

In addition to the club's restaurant and bar, The Nest, more dining options will be available once the resort is officially open. This would include an all-day dining multi-ethnic restaurant, an alfresco bar with western cuisine, and a bar for wines, cocktails and bar bites.

Similarly, the Dusit Thani's facilities will be available for booking by Laguna National members.

These include a fully-equipped gym, a spa centre, swimming pools and outdoor tennis courts.

Early next year, Laguna National will add to their training facilities with the addition of a nine-hole putting course.

Laguna Putting powered by Jack Nicklaus will span across 600 square metres and will be made of premium grade synthetic turf, which provides a near-identical experience to natural grass.

"Our ongoing efforts to benchmark Laguna National as a golf destination locally and regionally is two-fold – as a club of choice for members and guests and a preferred destination for major championships," said Mark Isley, Laguna National's general manager.

He added, "Our team continuously strives to raise the

bar, through the incorporation of technology as well. We are excited about sharing new developments and opportunities, especially with the newly opened Clubhouse and the impending debut of Dusit Thani Laguna Singapore, which will allow our members to enjoy a set of social and recreation privileges."

When golf courses were

reopened in phase two of the post circuit breaker period, Laguna National rolled out the Laguna Ready2Golf Initiative to ensure the safety of golfers amid the Covid-19 pandemic.

A combined task force between Dusit Thani and Laguna National was established to oversee the implementation of safe management

measures across the clubhouse, golf course, driving range and dining outlets.

Such measures include the installation of temperature screening technology, the use of electrostatic sanitisation spray to disinfect buggies after each round and placement of automatic hand sanitiser dispensers throughout the club.
