What's required to drive self-imported cars here

WHAT'S NEEDED

- Proof that car is new
- For used cars, foreign vehicle registration documents
- For electric cars, EMA has to check that charging at home does not affect power grid
- Documents from accredited centres certifying car complies with emissions and safety standards
- Technical specifications from manufacturer to show if car is new or model has not been imported to Singapore

BRINGING IT IN

- Apply to have car shipped to Singapore
- Submit required documents to authorities for inspection
- Pay related customs duties and fees
- Once in-principle approval has been given, importer will present car for inspection at any of 9 authorised centres
- For used cars, additional emissions, fuel efficiency tests are required
- When car has passed inspection, importer may proceed to register car and bid for COE, buy motor insurance
