



HONMA TR21 X IRONS

The newest addition to the TR line-up, the Honma TR21 X irons are their most forgiving to date.

Taking design cues from the least forgiving of the TR series, the TR20 B, the TR21 X is dubbed as a player's distance iron with a clean aesthetic to boot.

The head is constructed with high-strength steel and features a thin, L-shaped cup face that allows for more flex which in turn, promotes faster ball speeds.

Internally, the forged iron sports a hollow design with an internal tungsten bar that lowers the club's centre of gravity for increased launch and less twisting on off-centre hits.

The weight of the tungsten bar varies with the club's loft from 42 grams (2 to 4 iron) to 73 grams (9 to 11 iron). Filling the hollow space is Honma's proprietary injected low-density foam that optimises its feel and acoustics.

For golfers who opt for combo sets, the aesthetics of the TR21 X will match seamlessly with the TR20 B, V and P series irons.

The TR21 X is part of Honma's latest additions to the TR family which includes the TR21 FTi "BIG-LB" Fairway Metal, TR21 F Fairways and TR21 H Hybrids.

MIZUNO M-CRAFT PUTTERS

After seven years, Mizuno makes a return to the putter category with the launch of their M-Craft series.

The new line-up offers three models — the M-Craft 1, 2 and 3 — that are forged and CNC milled with 1025 mild carbon steel.

Weighing in at 355 grams, each model is designed to match with the various types of putting arcs.

The M-Craft 1, with its square back head shape and mid slant neck, is more suited for exaggerated putting arcs, while the M-Craft 2 features a classic heel-toe head shape with a plumber's neck for moderate putting arcs.

The M-Craft 3 is a mid-mallet head shape putter best suited for golfers with less arc, or who simply have a

preference for mallet putters.

There is also a certain degree of adjustability across the three models, giving the ability to fine-tune each putter to suit various putting conditions.

Each putter comes standard with dual eight-gram weights which can be interchanged for three or 13-gram weights that come with the additional weight kit.

Each model is available in three finishes. A traditional white satin, a striking blue ion and a stealthy black ion, topped off with a premium headcover in Mizuno's classic staff colours and a stitched leather M-Craft mark.
