First Green Mark Platinum-rated buildings in their respective sectors:

Other notable Green Mark Platinum-rated developments:

- **Edward Boustead Centre** (*headquarters*): showcases how high levels of eco-sustainability can be designed into small or large-scale industrial developments
- **ALICE@Mediapolis** (*left*): Singapore's first truly smart business park development

JTC Kranji Green:

Boustead's largest project, to date, and also its first public-sector project. A centrepiece within Singapore's national agenda, as the largest multi-storey recycling facility here.



Takeda Zero Energy Building (still under construction):

- Four-floor office building, earmarked to achieve the Green Mark Platinum (Zero Energy) certification
- Intended to serve as a model for other future Zero Energy Building projects where buildings generate enough energy from renewable energy sources to be self-sufficient and without drawing energy from the power grid
- Represents the ideal built environment to promote climate resilience
