Singapore shares rise 1.1%, lifted by DBS' above expectation earnings

Across the broader market, losers outnumber gainers 348 to 284, after 2.1b securities worth S\$3b are traded. BY RENALD YEO

SINGAPORE stocks ended higher on Thursday (Apr 30), led by gains in the benchmark index's largest constituent, DBS. The Straits Times Index (STI) rose 1.1 per cent, or 51.72 points, to 4,912.69, recouping some of the losses seen earlier in the week.

This was as the three local banks closed higher. DBS climbed 3.4 per cent, or S\$1.94, to S\$58.50; while OCBC gained 1.1 per cent, or S\$0.24, to S\$21.90. UOB added 1 per cent, or S\$0.37, to S\$36.15. Across the broader market, losers outnumbered gainers 348 to 284, after 2.1 billion securities worth S\$3 billion were traded.

Among STI constituents, Wilmar International was the worst performer, falling 5.7 per cent, or S\$0.22, to S\$3.61. DBS was the top gainer after reporting net profit of S\$2.93 billion for the three months ended Mar 31, up 1 per cent year on year and above analysts' expectations. The lender al-

so raised its 2026 deposit growth outlook, citing stronger-than-expected inflows, with its earnings outlook turning slightly more positive.

For the truncated trading week - with markets closed on Friday for a public holiday - the STI is down 1.7 per cent. Top gainers for the week were Yangzijiang Shipbuilding, up 5.4 per cent; UOL Group, up 4.6 per cent; and DFI Retail Group, up 2.7 per cent.

Top losers were Mapletree Pan-Asia Commercial Trust, down 8.5 per cent; Keppel, down 8.1 per cent; and Sats, down 7 per cent.

Elsewhere in the region, markets were mixed. Hong Kong's Hang Seng Index fell 1.3 per cent; Japan's Nikkei 225 declined 1.1 per cent; and South Korea's Kospi dropped 1.4 per cent; while Malaysia's FTSE Bursa Malaysia KLCI edged up 0.1 per cent.

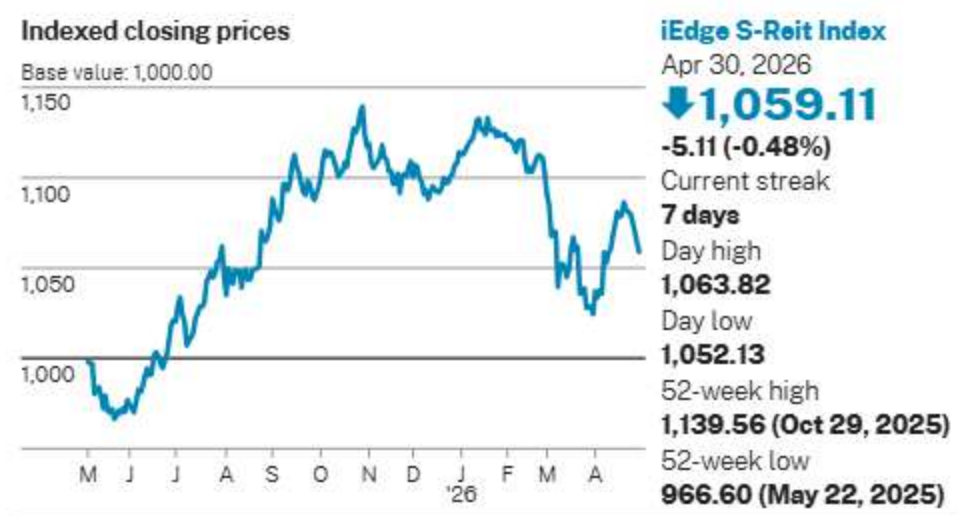

US dollar tumbles versus yen as Japanese officials signal intervention

THE US dollar fell sharply against the yen and eased versus the euro on Thursday (Apr 30) as oil prices dropped after rising earlier in the session and officials sent firm signals about possible intervention to support the Japanese currency.

Japanese Finance Minister Satsuki Katayama said just before 0800 GMT that the time to take "decisive" action in the market was nearing. The dollar/yen was down 0.45 per cent at 159.45 after Katayama's remarks, then fell sharply in a matter of minutes after 1030 GMT from 159.50 to 157.8.

It was last down 2 per cent at 157. It had hit 160.72 earlier in the session, its highest level since July 2024. "We cannot fully exclude the Bank of Japan (BOJ) is intervening,

but this looks more like an exacerbated reaction to the final warning by Mimura earlier this morning," ING forex strategist Francesco Pesole said.

"There has been some speculation the BOJ may intervene during a holiday period. Some European markets are closed tomorrow and UK markets are closed on Monday, so perhaps some market participants are closing short-yen/dollar positions ahead of that," he added.

Analysts flagged that intervention could prevent the dollar/yen from rising above the 162/165 range. The wild card, however, would be whether the US Treasury got involved.

Safe-haven demand lifted the dollar in March after the Iran war

broke out, underscored by the US economy's relatively lower exposure to higher oil prices compared with the eurozone and Japan. Investors are weighing higher

oil prices, which tend to pressure the yen, against fears that Japanese authorities could step in to support the currency around the 160 level.

The dollar index was down 0.59 per cent at 98.33 after hitting 99.092, its highest level since Apr 13.

The euro rose 0.36 per cent to US\$1.176 as oil prices fell.

"Concern that the current ceasefire could be followed by renewed conflict and further pressure on global oil supplies can be a trigger for the dollar to make a move higher," said Kit Juckes, macro strategist at SGCIB, recalling that the single currency fell to around 1.14 at the start of the conflict.

Efforts to resolve the conflict have hit an impasse, which the US is trying to unlock with a naval blockade of Iran's oil exports, Tehran's economic lifeline.

Analysts have argued that a potential nuclear deal was the main sticking point for a peace deal in the Middle East, as any agreement that leaves Iran's nuclear programme largely unchanged could be politically damaging for the US president Donald Trump at home.

With talks stalled, Trump is

slated to receive a briefing on Thursday on plans for a series of fresh military strikes on Iran, according to an Axios report late on Wednesday.

US Federal Reserve chair Jerome Powell closed out his eight years in office with rates on hold amid rising inflation concerns. The Fed's 8-4 decision to leave rates unchanged was its most divided since 1992, drawing three dissenters from officials who no longer think the bank should communicate a bias towards easing.

Trump expects Kevin Warsh, his pick to succeed Powell on May 15, to deliver rate cuts. Warsh has said he did not promise Trump he would do so. "Now would be a good time to cut interest rates and Warsh should convince his colleagues on the FOMC to take such action," Michael Pfister, forex strategist at Commerzbank, said.

"Yesterday's dissenters show that this will not be easy, if he even wants to," he added, mentioning the removal of the easing bias. REUTERS
