| <b>Some key Requirements</b> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>■ Applications open in mid-January 2021</li><li>■ Negative pre-departure test result</li><li>■ On-arrival Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) test; rapid test almost every other day</li><li>■ Stay at dedicated facility and within pre-declared group</li></ul> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>■ Sponsor from Singapore-based company or government to help apply for SafeTravel Pass</li><li>■ Negative pre-departure test result</li><li>■ On-arrival PCR test; self-isolate while waiting for test result</li><li>■ Stay in non-residential lodging with attached toilet</li><li>■ Adhere to a controlled itinerary for the first 14 days</li><li>■ Malaysia and Japan travellers to serve 14-day stay-home notice</li></ul> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>■ Apply for Air Travel Pass</li><li>■ Remain in places stated above last 14 consecutive days before coming to Singapore</li><li>■ On-arrival PCR test; self-isolate while waiting for test result</li></ul> |
