


Olam in United States

While better known for its presence in Africa, the US represents the single largest country for Olam's operations.



Key milestones

2002: Olam places its first employee to source cotton in North Carolina

2003/2004: Establishes its first sales and marketing arm on the east coast for cashews and coffee

2007: It acquires peanut blancher Universal Blanchers in Georgia for US\$77 million and Australia's Queensland Cotton (which has operations in Texas and California) for A\$166.45 million

2010: The group buys the dehydrated vegetable

processing business of Gilroy Foods and Flavours – one of the largest processors of onions, garlic and capsicums in North America – for US\$250 million

2014: It further expands peanut operations with purchase of McCleskey Mills Inc for US\$176 million

2015: Olam acquires ADM Cocoa for US\$1.3 billion

June 2016: It strengthens its position as most vertically integrated peanut player by buying Brooks Peanuts for US\$85 million
