# Singapore shares settle higher, tracking regional indices; STI up 1%

Across the broader market, gainers outnumber decliners 385 to 178, as 1.5b securities worth S\$1.7b change hands. BY RANAMITA CHAKRABORTY

SHARES on the Singapore bourse ended higher on Wednesday (Apr 23), tracking gains in the region. The uptick followed remarks from US President Donald Trump, who signalled no plans to dismiss Federal Reserve chairman Jerome Powell and suggested the possibility of lower tariffs for China.

The benchmark Straits Times Index rose 1 per cent or 36.91 points to 3,832.32. Across the broader market, gainers outnumbered decliners 385 to 178, after 1.5 billion securities worth S\$1.7 billion changed hands.

The top gainer on the index was Mapletree Logistics Trust. The counter rose 3.4 per cent or S\$0.04 to S\$1.21. Meanwhile, the biggest decliner was ST Engineering, which slid 3.8 per cent or S\$0.28 to S\$7.08.

The trio of local banks closed in positive territory, with DBS up 2.5 per cent or S\$1.03 at S\$42.88. OCBC rose 1.3 per cent or S\$0.21 to S\$16.59, and UOB gained 1.2

per cent or S\$0.41 to finish at S\$35.95.

Key indices across Asia closed higher on Wednesday, as optimism around the easing of US-China trade tensions grew. Hong Kong's Hang Seng Index rose 2.4 per cent, Japan's Nikkei 225 gained 1.9 per cent, South Korea's Kospi advanced 1.6 per cent, and Malaysia's FTSE Bursa Malaysia KLCI was up 1 per cent.

Eli Lee, chief investment strategist at Bank of Singapore, noted that broad-based weakness in US equities, Treasuries and the greenback will exert "significant pressure" on Trump to de-escalate. "We see market volatility staying heightened over the near term given limited progress made in the US trade discussions, and uncertainty over President Trump's recent threats to remove Fed chairman Jerome Powell, which he has since attempted to walk back from," he said.

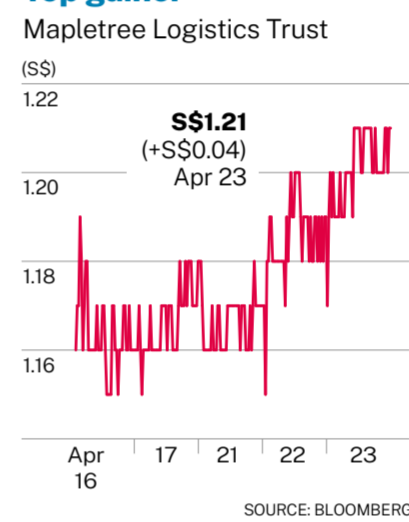

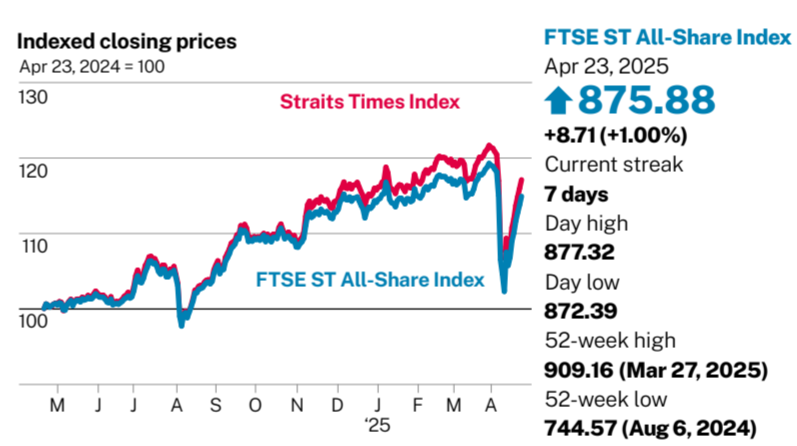

# US dollar makes tentative recovery; euro eases

THE greenback staged a tentative rebound against its major peers on Wednesday (Apr 23) on hopes of de-escalating trade tensions and as President Donald Trump backed away from threats to fire the head of the Federal Reserve, offering relief to investors.

Markets this week have been grappling with the notion that the Fed's independence could be under threat after repeated verbal attacks by Trump on Fed chair Jerome Powell for not cutting rates since the president took office again in January.

But late on Tuesday, Trump appeared to back down.

"I have no intention of firing him," Trump told reporters in the Oval Office on Tuesday. "I would like to see him be a little more active in terms of his idea to lower in-

terest rates."

Lee Hardman, senior currency analyst at MUFG, said the "outright denial" from Trump was an encouraging signal for the markets. Trump and US Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent separately suggested that there could be a de-escalation in US-China trade tensions and any trade deal with China could "substantially" cut tariffs.

Investors hastened back to the US dollar, which has been hovering near three-year lows in recent weeks and whose safe-haven status had been questioned in view of Trump's erratic trade policies and their potential impact on the US economy.

The greenback rose rapidly at the start of the trading day in Asian hours, but it has steadied since then as market sentiment re-



mained fragile.

"As we've seen, Trump seems to change his mind every other day. So, when you've got such uncertainty over policy in the US, it takes

more than just a couple of positive announcements to fully restore confidence," Hardman added.

The euro eased 0.18 per cent to US\$1.1397, pulling back from the

US\$1.15 levels it saw earlier this week that marked a roughly three-and-a-half-year high. Surveys on Wednesday showed eurozone business growth stalling and Germany's private sector contracting this month, hurt by service sector woes and trade-related uncertainty.

"That should place some downward pressure on the euro, of course. The dollar is likely to be a beneficiary on the back of that," said Nicholas Rees, Head of Macro Research at Monex Europe.

The US dollar climbed more

than 1 per cent against the yen to 143.21 in early trading and was last up 0.3 per cent at 142.085.

Against the Swiss franc, the US dollar was last 0.6 per cent stronger at 0.8245, having jumped more than 1 per cent earlier in the Asian session.

Despite its attempted rebound, the greenback is not far off its multi-year lows against the euro and the Swiss franc and a seven-month low versus the Japanese yen.

"We think this is going to be a theme going forward. We will see continued shocks that place downward pressure on the dollar, repeated walk backs to see the (US) dollar bounce. But again, the (US) dollar will not return to previous highs," Rees added.
