

Covid-19 vaccines and Phase 3

Free vaccination for all

- Covid-19 vaccine to be free and available to **all long-term residents** by end-2021
 - **Priority** for healthcare workers, frontline personnel, elderly, and vulnerable
 - **Pfizer-BioNTech** vaccine now authorised; other vaccines to come
 - Pregnant women, immuno-compromised persons, and those younger than 16 **should not receive it yet**, until more data is available
 - **By Q3 2021**, Singapore should have enough vaccine supplies for its population

Phase 3 begins Dec 28

- **Up to 8 people** may gather socially or visit households
 - Capacity limit for **malls and large standalone stores** raised to 10 square metres per person, up from current 8 sqm
 - **Attractions** can apply to increase operating capacity to 65 per cent, up from current 50 per cent
 - **Religious organisations** can have up to 250 persons in services, in zones of up to 50 each for congregational services
 - For **marriage solemnisations** at home, up to 8 visitors are allowed, beyond the existing cap of 10 persons including the host household
 - Up to 250 persons, in zones of up to 50 each, allowed for **indoor live performances**; outdoor live performance pilots to expand to similar numbers
