## **CHIPPING WITH EASE**

While the Tour pros train tirelessly to dial in their game, most amateurs are simply out to enjoy a casual game.

Enter the new CBX Full-Face and Smart Sole 4, designed to make the game easier ever so slightly.

A new addition to their line-up, the CBX Full-Face sports a high toe profile with a half-cavity design near the heel that moves the CG forward, allowing the face to slide under the ball with ease.

As the name suggests, Cleveland's signature Rotex Face Milling now extends across the entire face, along with Laser Milling and Tour Zip Grooves. The large surface area and high toe profile provide a large surface area for added confidence, even with open-face shots.

The CBX Full-Face also sports the brand's lowest grind to date, a low C-shaped sole that improves playability from any face angle.

Building on the popular series, the Smart Sole 4 wedges feature an extra-wide sole and extra leading edge bounce to improve contact and stability.

Available in three options — the C, S and the new

G model — the wedges are designed with a three-tiered sole at different widths for each model.

The CG is moved closer to the centre of the face with their improved Feel Balancing technology, redistributing weight from the hosel for better feel and consistency.

On the face, the sharp edges of the CNC Milled grooves increase spin and forgiveness when executing crucial greenside shots onto the green.

## GIVING YOU SPEED AND DISTANCE

Titleist is making bold claims with the launch of their new three-piece design golf ball, the Tour Speed.

To be exact, Titleist claims that its newest urethane cover addition outperforms many other golf balls



in speed and distance.

The Tour Speed's value proposition is providing the same, high-level performance of its top tier balls at a lower price point, making it ideal for amateur golfers.

Within the Tour Speed's thermoplastic urethane (TPU) cover is a high-speed core formulation wrapped with an ionomer casing layer that provides more distance off the tee without sacrificing greenside spin for more short game control.

The TPU exterior also sports a new 346 quadrilateral dipyramid dimple design that optimises aerodynamics to deliver a penetrating and consistent ball flight.

The Tour Speed was built on the research and testing of their experimental golf ball — the EXP•01 — which was an early prototype that was released late last year.
