

Tap and go: A better way to pay?



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COMPATIBLE DEVICES

iPhone 6 and later models;
Apple Watch (paired with iPhone5
and later models); iPad (Pro, Air 2,
mini 3 and later models).

19 smartphone
models, including
those of LG,
Samsung and Sony.



SETUP

Open Wallet app on Apple device,
add credit or debit card.
(Only for American Express
cardholders for now).

Install new* EZ-Link NFC SIM card
– purchased from M1, Singtel or
StarHub – in NFC-enabled
smartphone. Top up ez-link purse.

TO PAY

Hold device near retailers'
contactless readers with finger
on Touch ID. No need to open
an app or wake device display.

Activate NFC function on
smartphone. Tap smartphone at
public transport gantries or
retailers' card readers.

SECURITY

Retailers don't get credit card
details. Only device owner can
make payments as iPhone and
iPad require Touch ID or
a passcode, and Apple Watch
must be unlocked.

If owner loses his smartphone, he
can block the embedded ez-link
purse provided he has registered
on EZ-Link's Activate! programme.
He can also request to claim the
remaining monies in the lost card.

Android Pay,
Samsung Pay to
launch in S'pore
later this year.



* New EZ-Link NFC SIM cards issued from March 29,
2016, facilitate both public transport as well as retail
payments. Old cards expiring before August 26, 2020,
cannot be used for public transport payments.
