STOCKS

Singapore shares end lower amid geopolitical uncertainty; STI down 0.6%

Across the broader market, decliners outnumbered advancers 368 to 210, after 1.5b securities worth S\$1.7b change hands. **BY RANAMITA CHAKRABORTY**

SINGAPORE stocks ended lower on Thursday (Apr 2) as regional indices also closed in the red.

This followed President Donald Trump's announcement that the US would continue its attacks on Iran without committing to a specific timeline to end the conflict, sparking investor concerns.

The benchmark Straits Times Index (STI) lost 0.6 per cent or 28.33 points to finish at 4,947.50. Meanwhile, the iEdge Singapore Next 50 Index gained 1.3 per cent or 18.22 points to 1,467.36.

On the iEdge Singapore Next 50 Index, China Aviation Oil was the top gainer, rising 2.4 per cent or S\$0.05 to finish at S\$2.12. Food Empire was the top decliner, falling 6.1 per cent or S\$0.19 to end the session at S\$2.90.

Across the broader market, decliners outnumbered advancers 368 to

210, after 1.5 billion securities worth S\$1.7 billion changed hands.

DFI Retail Group led the gainers on the STI, rising 1.4 per cent or US\$0.06 to end at US\$4.34. The biggest decliner was Hongkong Land, falling 3.8 per cent or US\$0.31 to close at US\$7.79.

The local banks ended the day mixed. DBS closed flat at S\$57.55. OCBC fell 0.8 per cent or S\$0.17 to S\$22.38 and UOB was down 0.3 per cent or S\$0.12 at S\$36.91.

Key regional indices were in negative territory. Hong Kong's Hang Seng Index lost 0.7 per cent, Japan's Nikkei 225 index fell 2.4 per cent, South Korea's Kospi was down 4.5 per cent and the FTSE Bursa Malaysia KLCI declined 0.6 per cent.

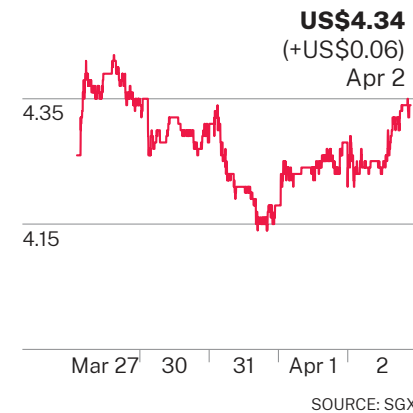

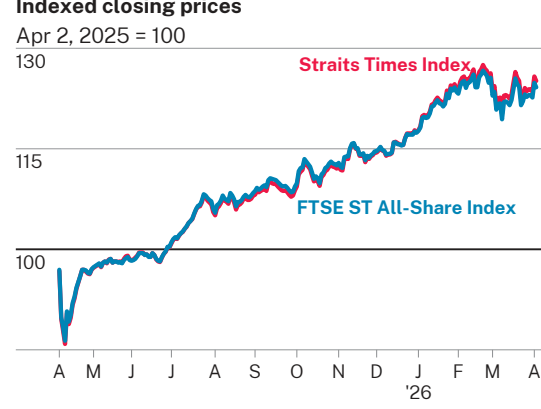

US dollar jumps; euro, sterling give up recent gains

THE US dollar rose sharply on Thursday (Apr 2) after US President Donald Trump's address on Iran shattered hopes for a swift end to the conflict, sending investors towards safe-haven assets as oil prices jumped and stocks tumbled.

In a televised speech, Trump vowed more aggressive strikes on Iran in the next two to three weeks, offering no concrete timeline to open the Strait of Hormuz or end a war that has rattled investors and roiled markets.

Iran's military responded with a warning for the United States and Israel of "more crushing, broader and more destructive" attacks in store.

Investors were quick to sell riskier assets such as stocks and buy the US dollar, pushing the yen, euro

and sterling lower.

The dollar index, which measures the greenback against a basket of currencies, climbed 0.68 per cent to 100.24 as the safe-haven trade came back on, putting it on track for its best day since Mar 18.

Thursday's advance wiped out most of the greenback's declines from the past two days amid earlier optimism about de-escalating the Iran war, putting it on track for another winning week.

Stocks slid and oil prices surged, with Brent crude futures rising almost 8 per cent to US\$109.10 per barrel, after Trump's address sparked fresh concerns about sustained disruption.

"Trump's comments failed to reassure markets ... markets are



starting to realise that the war will probably escalate further from here before de-escalating," said Carol Kong, a currency strategist at Commonwealth Bank of Australia.

"The dollar can definitely increase further from here against all the major currencies" as markets wake up to the fact that the global economy will slow down material-

ly, she added.

Non-dollar currencies extended their falls as oil prices climbed in European trading.

The euro fell 0.66 per cent to US\$1.1513 and sterling slid 0.88 per cent to US\$1.319, both giving up some recent gains.

The risk-sensitive Australian dollar, commonly seen as a barometer of global growth expectations, fell 0.95 per cent to US\$0.6863.

The Japanese yen traded 0.6 per cent weaker at 159.72 per dollar, nearing the psychologically important 160 level that is viewed as the

line in the sand for intervention by Japanese authorities.

Trump's comments also sent US Treasury yields higher on growing fears that inflation from higher oil prices would close the door to rate cuts.

That sets the stage for Friday's US non-farm payrolls report. The market is looking for a 60,000 rise in jobs for March, according to the median estimate of economists polled by Reuters.

"Another miss could rattle the markets and crank the volume up on the chorus warning about stagflation," said Kyle Rodda, senior financial market analyst at Capital.com.

"The markets could be extra choppy going into the Easter long weekend." REUTERS
