Singapore shares fall after US strikes Iran; STI down 0.1%

Across the broader market, losers beat gainers 269 to 217, after 1.2b securities worth S\$1.3b change hands. **BY TAN NAI LUN**

LOCAL stocks ended lower on Monday (Jun 23) amid a mixed trading session in the region, after the US launched strikes on three of Iran's nuclear facilities over the weekend.

The benchmark Straits Times Index (STI) fell 0.1 per cent or 4.17 points to 3,879.26.

Across the broader market, losers beat gainers 269 to 217, after 1.2 billion securities worth S\$1.3 billion changed hands.

Across the region, key indices were mixed. Hong Kong's Hang Seng Index gained 0.7 per cent and the FTSE Bursa Malaysia KLCI rose 0.9 per cent.

Meanwhile, Japan's Nikkei 225 lost 0.1 per cent and South Korea's Kospi Composite Index slipped 0.2 per cent.

Markets have been very resilient this year despite tariff shocks, inflation fears and geopolitical concerns, said Vasu Menon, managing director of investment strategy at OCBC.

While these events caused brief sell-

offs, stock prices rebounded afterwards, and the snapbacks have been relatively fast and sharp, he noted.

"What's going for markets is a lot of idle liquidity on the sidelines that could provide market support, should there be sharp pullbacks," Menon said.

"This means that such pullbacks will offer an opportunity to buy or accumulate, rather than a reason to run for cover."

On the STI, Thai Beverage was the top gainer, rising 2.2 per cent or S\$0.01 to S\$0.455.

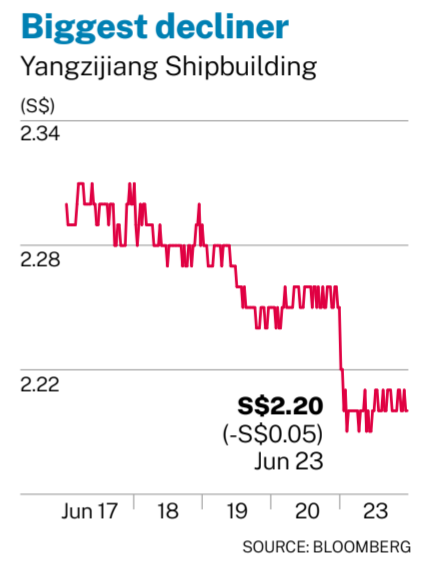
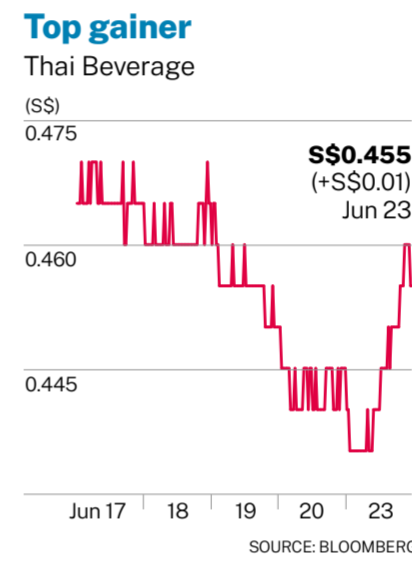
Yangzijiang Shipbuilding was the biggest decliner on the index, falling 2.2 per cent or S\$0.05 to S\$2.20.

The three local banks ended mixed on Monday. DBS fell 0.05 per cent or S\$0.02 to S\$43.86, UOB lost 0.4 per cent or S\$0.14 to S\$34.75, while OCBC rose 0.3 per cent or S\$0.04 to S\$15.94.

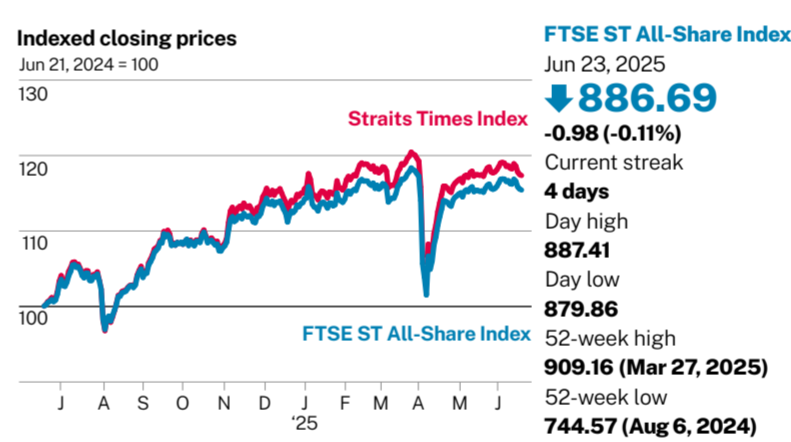

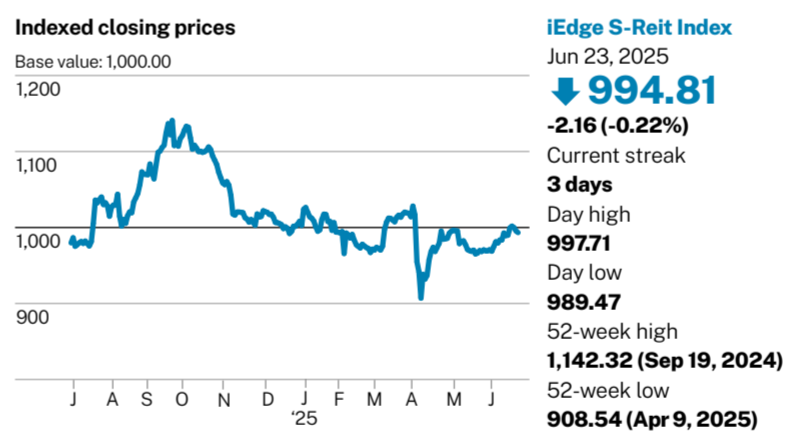

US dollar up as Mid-East conflict rages; yen sinks

THE greenback firmed on Monday (Jun 23) with the yen at a more than six-week low as investors anticipated a response from Iran to US attacks on its nuclear sites, though some analysts said the FX reaction had been relatively muted.

Iran said on Monday the US attack on its nuclear sites had expanded the range of legitimate targets for its armed forces and called US President Donald Trump a "gambler" for joining Israel's military campaign against the Islamic Republic.

ING FX strategist Francesco Pesole said the muted response in FX markets is due in part to a structural lack of appetite for long dollar positions.

"Markets need more than what would normally be required to enter long dollar positions," he said.

"At the same time, markets are still not willing to price in a full-blown conflict in the area."

The major moves were in the oil market, with crude prices hitting a five-month high before dipping to trade lower on the day.

The dollar firmed 1.3 per cent against the yen and was last at 147.7 - its highest since May 15.

Bank of America strategists said dollar/yen can reprice higher if oil prices remain elevated, noting Japan imports almost all of its oil, more than 90 per cent of which comes from the Middle East, while the US is largely energy-independent.

The euro declined 0.5 per cent to US\$1.147, but was largely unfazed after euro area flash PMIs showed the region's economy flat-lined for a second month in June.



Slightly improving UK flash PMIs failed to move the dial on sterling, which last fetched US\$1.3389, 0.46 per cent lower against the dollar.

Meanwhile, the Australian dol-

lar, often seen as a risk proxy, hit a one-month low and was last 1.1 per cent weaker at US\$0.63815, while the New Zealand dollar sank 1.3 per cent to US\$0.589.

That left the dollar index, which

measures the US currency against six other units, 0.38 per cent higher at 99.3.

Carol Kong, currency strategist at Commonwealth Bank of Australia, said the markets are in wait-and-see mode on how Iran responds, with more worries about the positive inflationary impact of the conflict than the negative economic impact.

"The currency markets will be at the mercy of comments and actions from the Iranian, Israeli and US governments," Kong said.

"The risks are clearly skewed to further upside in the safe-haven currencies if the parties escalate

the conflict."

Iran vowed to defend itself a day after the US dropped 30,000-pound bunker-buster bombs onto the mountains above the Fordow nuclear site. American leaders urged Tehran to stand down, while pockets of anti-war protests emerged in US cities.

In a step towards what is widely seen as Iran's most effective threat to hurt the West, its parliament approved a move to close the Strait of Hormuz. Nearly a quarter of global oil shipments pass through the narrow waters that Iran shares with Oman and the United Arab Emirates.

The US currency has dropped 8.6 per cent this year against its major rivals as economic uncertainty from Trump's tariffs began to reverberate. REUTERS
