

# Key regulatory announcements in 2020

<b>Date</b>	<b>Announcement</b>
<b>Nov 20</b>	Consults on management default process
<b>Nov 13</b>	Enhances IPO, RTO due diligence standards
<b>Sept 29</b>	Extends electronic dissemination of rights issue, takeover documents to Jun 30, 2021
<b>Aug 12</b>	To enhance investor protection for dual listings with Israel Securities Authority
<b>Aug 6</b>	Seeks swifter enforcement outcomes, wants issuers to have whistleblowing policy
<b>Jun 26</b>	Issues Best Practices Guide for Singapore lawyers
<b>May 11</b>	Removes minimum trading price rule, refines exit requirement to financial watch list
<b>Apr 22</b>	Grants auto-extension for release of unaudited FY financial results
<b>Apr 8</b>	Suspends entry into the financial watch-list, enhanced share issue limit for mainboard issuers
<b>Apr 7</b>	Grants a 60-day extension to firms whose AGMs are due during April 16 - July 31, 2020
<b>Mar 19</b>	Issues guidance on general meetings
<b>Feb 27</b>	Gives additional two months to issuers to hold AGMs
<b>Feb 12</b>	Uses AI to enhance surveillance activities
<b>Feb 7</b>	Gives issuers up to June 30 to hold AGMs
<b>Jan 16</b>	Wants Singapore-registered auditor for all listed companies, proposes new rules on property valuers and valuations
<b>Jan 10</b>	Enhances rules governing mainboard listings, increases oversight over issue managers and due diligence standards
<b>Jan 9</b>	Adopts risk-based approach to quarterly reporting
<b>Jan 2</b>	Forms working group to review retail bonds framework
