# STI slides 1.2% as Brent crude oil price rises above US\$100

Across the broader market, losers beat gainers 389 to 226, with 1.8b securities worth S\$2.3b changing hands. **BY TAY PECK GEK**

SINGAPORE blue chips closed lower on Thursday (Apr 23) as Brent crude oil breached US\$100 a barrel amid persistent tensions in the Middle East. The benchmark Straits Times Index (STI) lost 1.2 per cent or 58.61 points to finish at 4,944.11.

Thai Beverage (ThaiBev) led the gainers on Singapore's blue-chip index by a far margin, rising 3.7 per cent or S\$0.015 to S\$0.425. It was one of the four STI stocks that managed to eke out an increase.

Agribusiness group Wilmar International, offshore and energy solutions provider Seatrrium, and data centre real estate investment trust Keppel DC Reit were the other STI constituents that closed higher.

Wilmar rose 0.5 per cent or S\$0.02 to S\$3.91. Seatrrium and Keppel DC Re-

it were both up 0.4 per cent or S\$0.01 to end at S\$2.37 and S\$2.38, respectively. The worst performer was Hongkong Land, which fell 4 per cent or US\$0.32 to close at US\$7.60.

The local banks all ended lower. DBS edged down 0.4 per cent or S\$0.20 to S\$5.7, OCBC dropped 3.5 per cent or S\$0.79 to S\$21.80 as it went ex-dividend, and UOB slid 0.3 per cent or S\$0.12 to S\$36.90.

Within the iEdge Singapore Next 50 Index, Olam was the top gainer, rising 6.7 per cent or S\$0.065 to finish at S\$1.04, while Hong Leong Asia was the biggest loser, falling 4.4 per cent or S\$0.15 to end the session at S\$3.25.

Across the broader market, losers beat gainers 389 to 226, with 1.8 billion securities worth S\$2.3 billion changing hands.

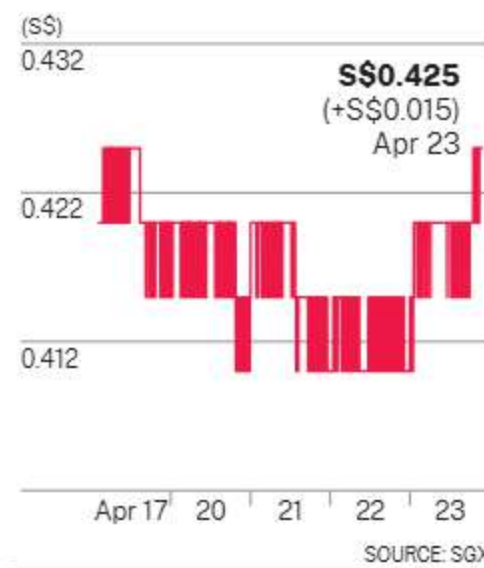
Key regional indices were mainly down. Hong Kong's Hang Seng Index lost 1 per cent, Japan's Nikkei 225 index fell 0.8 per cent. However, South Korea's Kospi was up 0.9 per cent.

Vishnu Varathan, head of macro strategy for Asia Pacific at Mizuho Securities (Singapore), noted that as flares of tensions persist in the Strait of Hormuz - with both US and Iran seizing or attacking vessels - Brent is pushed back above US\$100 per barrel and risk appetite likely checked at the margin.

The US military had intercepted several Iranian oil tankers in Asian waters recently, reigniting concerns that the Middle East conflict could be prolonged.

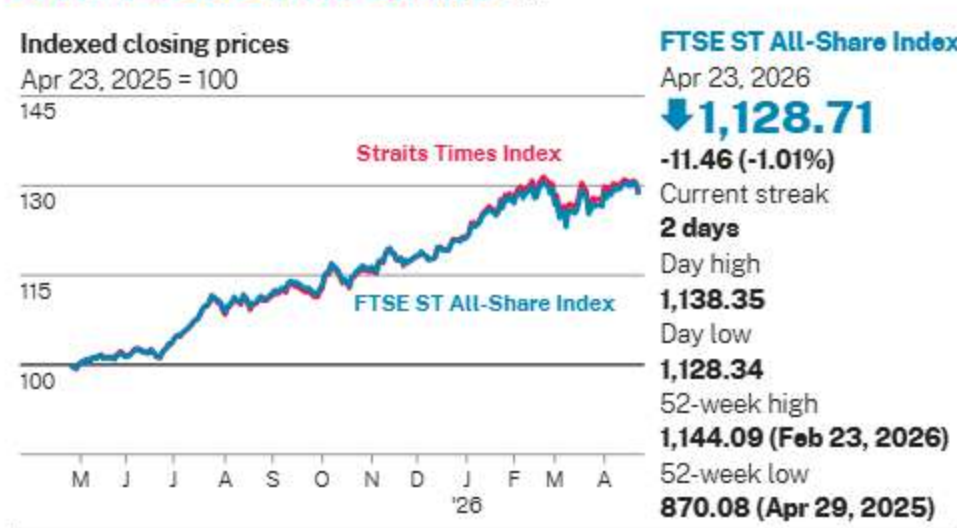

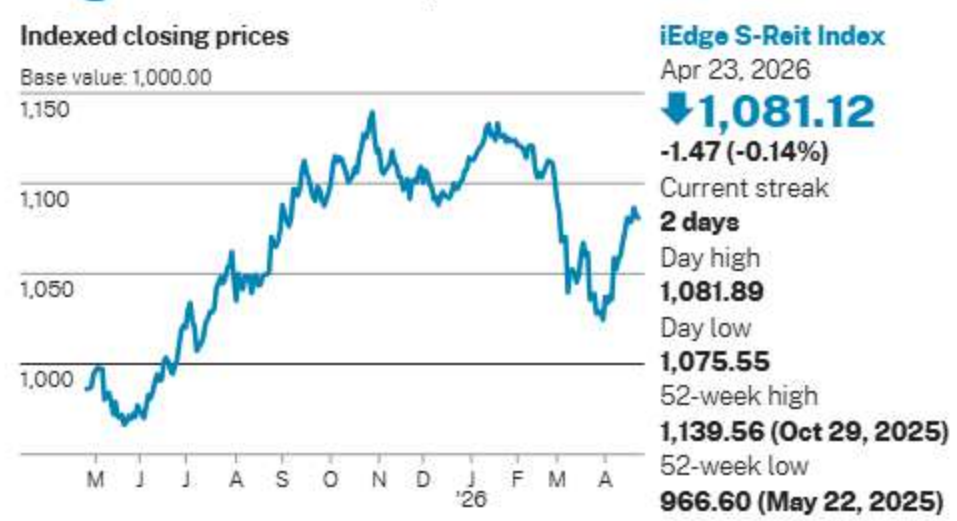

# Greenback gains on Iran-US stand-off

THE US dollar was headed for its first weekly rise in a month on Thursday (Apr 23), as a stand-off between Iran and the US in the Middle East and a lack of progress on peace talks sent oil prices back above US\$100 a barrel and dented investor optimism.

Teheran seized two ships in the Strait of Hormuz on Wednesday, escalating tensions after US President Donald Trump extended a ceasefire with Iran indefinitely with no sign of peace talks restarting.

The two sides remain divided on a ceasefire, their blockades, nuclear issues and control of the strait, leaving the strategic waterway still effectively shut and triggering an energy shock in a blow to economies across the world.

"For now, at least, it's still feeling

as though the path of least resistance is just a maintenance of just adding to dollar positions slightly, so, unwinding that sort of peace premium that had been put back into the market," CIBC Capital Markets head of G10 FX strategy Jeremy Stretch said.

The euro dipped below US\$1.17, having touched its lowest point since Apr 13 earlier on. The single currency is headed for a 0.7 per cent decline this week, its first drop in four weeks.

Sterling was down 0.1 per cent at US\$1.3488, shrugging off data that showed an early impact of the US-Israeli war on Iran on British consumers who scaled back their spending on fuel.

The Japanese yen was a touch weaker at 159.73, near the 160 level that many in the market view as the



line in the sand for official intervention. The Bank of Japan is expected to keep interest rates unchanged next week, but has hinted that a June hike is possible.

The dollar index, which tracks the performance of the US currency against six others, rose 0.17 per cent to 98.78. It is heading for a weekly rise of 0.4 per cent, the first

gain in a month.

The dollar emerged as the main beneficiary of the turmoil in March after the war erupted, but the prospect of a peace deal and a ceasefire earlier this month encouraged investors to buy more volatile currencies, which eroded most of those gains.

The nearly two-month war in the Middle East has led to soaring fuel prices, shattered consumer confidence and wiped out market pricing for rate cuts this year.

Trump on Tuesday said a currency swap with the United Arab Emirates was under consideration, following a report in *The Wall Street Journal* that suggested the UAE

central bank governor had raised the idea of a swap line with US Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent and Federal Reserve officials in meetings in Washington last week.

"In a sense, whenever we see episodes of instability, there are question marks regarding the ability to access credit or finance or liquidity," CIBC's Stretch said. "And clearly, these are nations which are also seeing significant influences in terms of their revenue streams because the flow of directives is being curtailed. So in a sense, it's a precautionary measure which is prudent."

On the rates front, markets show traders see a 25 per cent chance of a cut from the Fed this year, while pricing in two hikes from the European Central Bank in 2026. REUTERS
