

Calibrated override thresholds

Parliament majority required for override to be calibrated against level of support of CPA

Current override threshold

If President exercises veto,
and majority of CPA agrees
– **Parliament cannot override**

If President exercises veto,
and majority of CPA disagrees
– **Parliament can override veto
with two-thirds majority**

Commission's recommendation

If President exercises veto, and
absolute majority of CPA agrees
– **Parliament cannot override**

If President exercises veto, and CPA
is evenly split but CPA Chairman uses
casting vote in President's favour
– **Parliament can override with
two-thirds majority**

If President exercises veto, and
majority of CPA disagrees
– **Parliament can override veto
with simple majority**
