

Back to Phase Two

Singapore is tightening border and community measures amid the rise of Covid-19 cases and the appearance of more transmissible variants.

BORDER MEASURES From May 7, 11.59pm

- Prevailing border measures to be based on travel history of past 21 days, up from 14 days now
- Those with recent travel history to higher risk countries/regions must serve 21-day stay home notice at a dedicated facility

COMMUNITY MEASURES From May 8 to 30

- Five-person limit for social gatherings and daily household visitors
- No more than 50 per cent of employees who can work from home may return to the workplace
- Pre-event testing needed for congregational or worship services with more than 100 attendees; no congregational singing allowed
- Pre-event testing needed for wedding couple in solemnisations with more than 50 attendees; and for all attendees of receptions with over 50 attendees
- For funerals, no more than 30 attendees allowed on the day of burial or cremation
- All mass participation sports events suspended, no spectators allowed
- No more than 250 attendees at live performances and pilot business-to-business events; pre-event testing needed for events with more than 100 attendees
- Cinema attendance capped at 100, or at 250 with pre-event testing
- Reduced capacity for museums, public libraries, tours
- Closure of indoor gyms and indoor fitness/health studios
- Start date of TraceTogether-only SafeEntry brought forward to May 17; SafeEntry Gateway required at more venues from June 15
