

# New elements for the election

- All candidates must apply for and obtain a Community Certificate. This document will clearly state which community the candidate belongs to
- Candidates must sign a statutory declaration that they understand the role of the President
- There is a separate form that candidates can voluntarily sign, to indicate that they will campaign in a dignified, decorous and consistent manner with the President's position
- Four extra channels for Presidential Candidate Broadcasts, taking the total to 17. Each candidate will be allocated two blocks of 10 minutes' airtime, free of charge, to make his or her statements. The first broadcast will be on Sept 14, and the second is on Sept 21
- There will be two TV forums, instead of one previously. SPH will organise the first one on Sept 16, and MediaCorp the second one on Sept 19
- No designated rally sites. Those who want to hold rallies must secure a site on their own, obtain approval from the owners, and apply for a Police permit
- Election expenses limit for the Presidential Election is S\$754,982.40, or 30 cents per registered voter. The total number of eligible voters is 2,516,608
