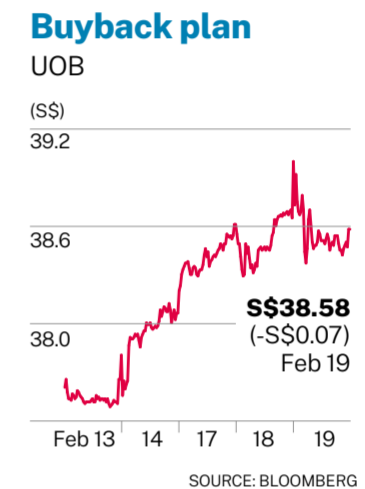
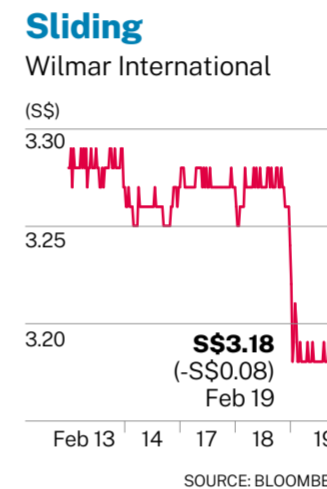
# Singapore shares extend advance on UOB results, Budget; STI up 0.2%

Across the broader market, losers beat gainers 269 to 254, after 1.4b securities worth S\$1.5b change hands. BY MEGAN CHEAH

SINGAPORE stocks closed higher on Wednesday (Feb 19), as investors digested company earnings reports and the country's Budget 2025 announcements. The Straits Times Index (STI) rose 8.48 points or 0.2 per cent to 3,934.04, below the record 3,943.23 that the index hit earlier in the day. Across the broader market, losers beat gainers 269 to 254, with 1.4 billion securities worth S\$1.5 billion changing hands. The benchmark index was led by maritime player Yangzijiang Shipbuilding, which gained 2.2 per cent or S\$0.07 to S\$3.20. Meanwhile, agribusiness Wilmar International fell 2.5 per cent or S\$0.08 to S\$3.18. Local bank UOB lost 0.2 per cent or S\$0.07 to S\$38.58, after it posted a net profit of S\$1.52 billion for the quarter ended December 2024, beating a S\$1.48 billion consensus forecast in a six-analyst Bloomberg poll.

The lender also announced a S\$3 billion capital distribution package to distribute surplus capital over the next three years, comprising special dividends and share buybacks. Following the results announcement, OCBC Investment Research raised its fair-value estimate for UOB to S\$41.50, as it revised earnings estimates for FY2025 and FY2026 to take into account fewer interest-rate cuts and better fee income. The two other local banks closed higher. DBS rose 0.5 per cent or S\$0.24 to S\$46.04, while OCBC climbed 0.5 per cent or S\$0.09 to S\$17.85. Elsewhere, regional indices ended the day mixed. Hong Kong's Hang Seng Index slipped 0.1 per cent, Japan's Nikkei 225 rose 0.3 per cent, South Korea's Kospi Composite Index advanced 1.7 per cent, while the Bursa Malaysia Kuala Lumpur Composite Index retreated 0.3 per cent.

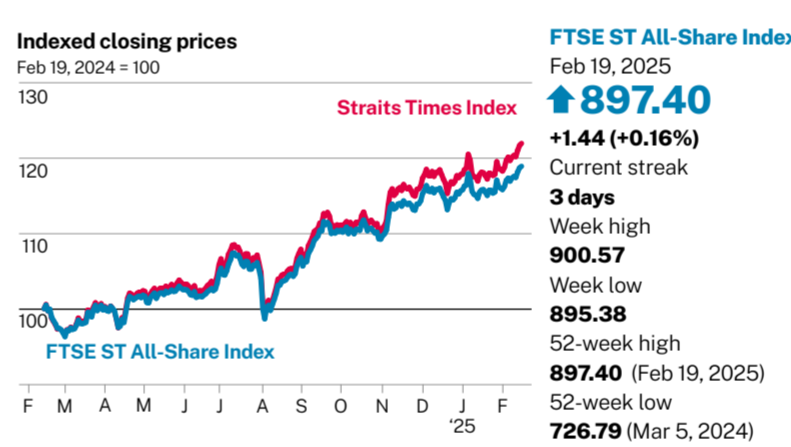

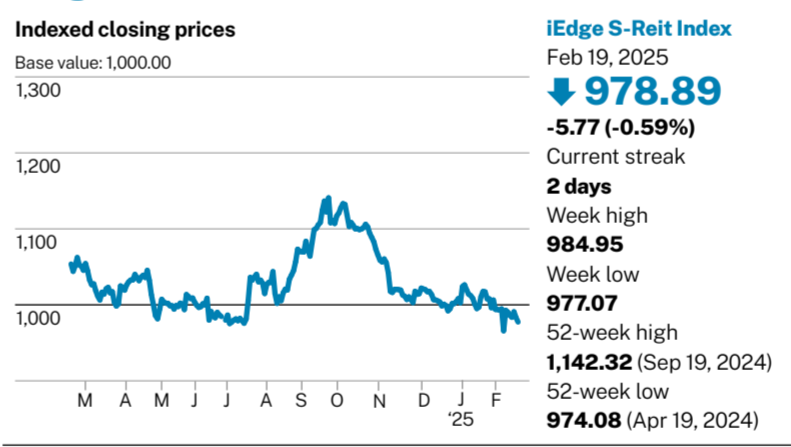

# US dollar rises with Ukraine talks, tariffs in focus

THE greenback strengthened against a range of currencies but slipped against the yen on Wednesday (Feb 19), as traders focused on talks over a Ukraine ceasefire and digested the latest round of tariff threats from US President Donald Trump.

The pound, meanwhile, got a short-lived boost from a stronger-than-expected UK inflation print.

The dollar index last stood at 107.2, up 0.19 per cent, after dropping 1.2 per cent last week. The yen was stronger against the dollar, up 0.1 per cent at 151.855.

The Trump administration said on Tuesday it had agreed to hold more talks with Russia on ending the war in Ukraine after an initial meeting that excluded Kyiv, a departure from Washington's previous approach that rallied US allies

to isolate Russian President Vladimir Putin.

Francesco Pesole, foreign exchange strategist at ING, pointed to the market's base case that a peace deal in Ukraine might be reached at some point. Meanwhile, the European Union's exclusion from the table at peace talks is seen as spurring safe-haven demand into the yen and out of the euro, he said.

The euro was down 0.4 per cent against the yen at 158.25, and down 0.2 per cent against the dollar at US\$1.0426.

Pesole highlighted the latest raft of tariff threats from Trump, but said the market was more focused on news around a potential Ukraine peace deal in the short term.

"There is a residual sort of reluctance in markets to see whether Trump will indeed go ahead with



tariffs on trade partners," he said.

Trump said on Tuesday he intends to impose auto tariffs "in the neighbourhood of 25 per cent" and similar duties on semiconductors and pharmaceutical imports, the

latest in a series of measures threatening to upend international trade.

"Amid all this chaotic, childish back and forth of the presidential tariff announcements, let's not

lose sight of what will ultimately come out of it – probably fewer tariffs than expected when he took office, but still substantial ones," Commerzbank forex analysts and strategists said in a note.

The euro was little moved by remarks from European Central Bank board member Isabel Schnabel, who on Wednesday told the *Financial Times* the central bank was edging closer to pausing rate cuts.

In the UK, official data showed inflation speeding up more than expected to hit a 10-month high of 3 per cent in January and is likely to rise further soon, testing the Bank

of England's confidence that price pressures will ease over the longer term.

Sterling was down 0.27 per cent at US\$1.25790, coming off a two-month high hit immediately after the data.

Against the euro, the pound was virtually unchanged at 82.86 pence. Pesole said the relatively safe position of the UK on trade and the latest inflation figures made the pound more attractive than the euro.

Elsewhere, the Reserve Bank of New Zealand reduced its benchmark rate by 50 basis points to 3.75 per cent on Wednesday as widely expected and signalled future moves would likely be smaller, leaving the currency up 0.2 per cent on the day at US\$0.5714.
