

New support measures for return to Phase 2 (Heightened Alert)



Firms

- Enhanced job support scheme payouts for affected sectors
 - Sectors that have to suspend operations (F&B, gyms and studios, performing arts and arts education)
 - 60 per cent from July 22 to Aug 18
 - 10 per cent from Aug 19 to Aug 31
 - Sectors that can operate but have been hit (retail, cinemas, tourism, affected personal care services, family entertainment, museums, art galleries, historical sites)
 - 40 per cent from July 22 to Aug 18
 - 10 per cent from Aug 19 to Aug 31
- **Rental relief for hawkers, SMEs and eligible non-profit organisations**
 - Additional four weeks rental waiver for those in government-owned commercial properties
 - Additional two weeks rental relief cash payout for those in privately-owned commercial properties
 - Looking to require sharing of rental obligations among the government, landlords, and qualifying tenants
- **Food delivery booster package**
 - Extension from July 22 to Aug 18, to help F&B businesses diversify revenue channels and defray business costs of going online



Market and hawker stall owners in centres managed by NEA or NEA-appointed operators

- Market and hawker centre relief fund
 - One-off cash assistance of S\$500 per stallholder



Taxi and private hire car drivers

- Enhancement of Covid-19 driver relief fund with an additional:
 - S\$10/vehicle/day from July 22 to Aug 31
 - S\$5/vehicle/day in September 2021.



Workers

- Extension of the temporary Covid-19 recovery grant to Aug 31, with the following payouts:
 - Up to S\$700 for workers placed on involuntary no-pay leave;
 - Up to S\$500 for those with significant income loss
