Seatrium surge leads Singapore shares slightly higher; STI up 0.1%

Across the broader market, gainers beat losers 316 to 267 after 2.3b securities change hands. **BY JUDE CHAN**

SINGAPORE stocks ended higher on Tuesday (May 12).

The benchmark Straits Times Index (STI) gained 0.1 per cent or 3.23 points to finish at 4,946.

Seatrium led the gainers on Singapore's blue-chip index, rising 5.4 per cent or S\$0.12 to S\$2.35.

The worst performer among STI constituents was Frasers Logistics & Commercial Trust, which fell 1.5 per cent or S\$0.015 to S\$0.97.

The three local banks ended the day mixed. DBS rose 0.6 per cent or S\$0.33 to S\$59.10, and UOB was up 0.3 per cent or S\$0.12 to S\$37.11. OCBC, meanwhile, finished 0.8 per cent or S\$0.17 lower at S\$22.33.

Within the iEdge Singapore Next 50 Index, Riverstone was the top gainer, rising 12.8 per cent or S\$0.105 to S\$0.925.

UOB Kay Hian was the index's biggest decliner, falling 2.6 per cent or S\$0.11 to end the session at S\$4.19.

Across the broader market, gainers beat losers 316 to 267, after 2.3 billion securities worth S\$2.2 billion changed hands.

Japan's Nikkei 225 rose 0.5 per cent, and the FTSE Bursa Malaysia KLCI advanced 0.3 per cent. Meanwhile, South Korea's Kospi was down 2.3 per cent, and Hong Kong's Hang Seng Index lost 0.2 per cent.

"We see no disconnect between record US equities prices and elevated oil, commodities and yields," said BlackRock Investment Institute, adding that markets were pricing in artificial intelligence-driven growth and the impact of the supply shock in the Middle East.

"US inflation data this week will test still-firm price pressures, with implications for yields as markets assess the risk of further rate increases," it added.

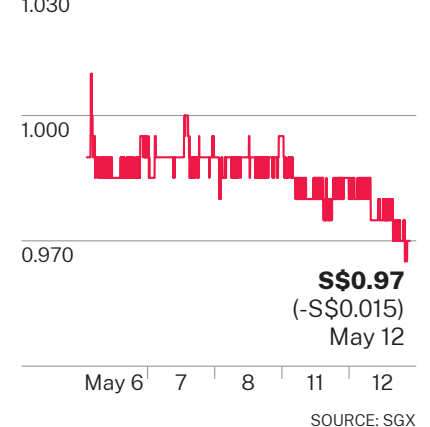

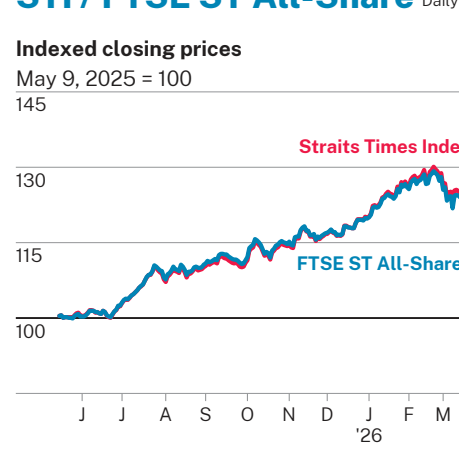

Greenback rises again; yen's jump stokes speculation

THE US dollar extended gains for a second straight session on Tuesday (May 12), underpinned by sustained uncertainty over the Middle East conflict that drove investors into the greenback as a traditional safe haven.

The greenback rose sharply in March as the currencies of oil-reliant economies such as Japan and the euro area were heavily sold after oil prices surged following Iran's effective closure of the Strait of Hormuz.

It weakened again after Apr 7, the start of a ceasefire, which US President Donald Trump threatened on Monday to end, dismissing Iran's proposal as "a piece of garbage".

The US dollar index, a measure of its value against a basket of major foreign currencies, was up

0.36 per cent at 98.30. It was at 97.85 on Feb 27 and hit 100.64 in late March. It fell below its pre-war levels late last week.

"It appears unlikely that a breakthrough would be achieved before the Trump-Xi summit later this week," said Mohit Kumar, an economist at Jefferies.

Trump is expected to arrive in Beijing on Wednesday, where Iran is set to be among the topics discussed with Chinese President Xi Jinping.

"As long as crude oil prices stay high, because of the US' blockade [of Iranian ports] and Iran's threat to tanker traffic in the Gulf, the dollar will stay strong," said Thierry Wizman, global forex and rates strategist at Macquarie Group.

will take on the rest of the world's economies will be much more pernicious than the toll on the US," he added.

Oil prices rose 3 per cent on Tuesday as hopes for a deal to end the war on Iran faded.

Wizman also argued that the US administration has probably decided that its economic blockade of Iran – the 'economic war' – could be more effective than re-summing bombing runs.

Investors are also closely watching the monetary outlook, with the Federal Reserve now expected to keep rates higher for longer, while traders are betting

that the European Central Bank will hike its depo rate to about 2.75 per cent by year-end from the current 2 per cent.

The euro fell 0.33 per cent to US\$1.1744.

The Japanese yen jumped suddenly in the late Asian session on Tuesday, stoking speculation of a "rate check", often a precursor to currency intervention.

The dollar was last at 157.57 against the yen, up 0.21 per cent on the day, after US Treasury Secretary Scott Bessent said that he had great confidence that Bank of Japan Governor Kazuo Ueda will guide the central bank to a "very successful" monetary policy.

Japan's authorities have supposedly spent nearly US\$63.7 billion in the current round of interventions. REUTERS
