# Genting Singapore leads decline as STI bucks regional gains

The iEdge Singapore Next 50 Index closes flat at 1,526.59. **BY BENICIA TAN**

SINGAPORE stocks ended lower on Wednesday (Feb 25), bucking regional gains, which tracked advances in the US market on artificial intelligence (AI) optimism.

The benchmark Straits Times Index (STI) lost 0.3 per cent or 13.06 points to finish at 5,007.73. Meanwhile, the iEdge Singapore Next 50 Index remained mostly unchanged at 1,526.59.

Across the broader market, gainers trailed losers 286 to 310, after 1.7 billion securities worth S\$2.3 billion changed hands.

The biggest decliner among the STI constituents was Genting Singapore, which fell 8.2 per cent or S\$0.065 to S\$0.725. The company on Tuesday posted a 30 per cent decline in second-half net profit.

The local banks all ended lower. DBS lost 0.3 per cent or S\$0.17 to finish

at S\$57.69. OCBC slipped 0.1 per cent or S\$0.03 to S\$21.40, and UOB was down 0.6 per cent or S\$0.22 at S\$36.98.

Meanwhile, DFI Retail Group led the blue-chip gainers with a 3.9 per cent or US\$0.16 rise to US\$4.30.

Within the iEdge Singapore Next 50 Index, SBS Transit was the top gainer, advancing 10.8 per cent or S\$0.37 to S\$3.81. Hong Leong Asia was the biggest loser, falling 10.3 per cent or S\$0.35 to S\$3.05.

Across the region, most key indices advanced. Hong Kong's Hang Seng gained 0.7 per cent, Japan's Nikkei 225 rose 2.2 per cent, and South Korea's Kospi was up 1.9 per cent. The FTSE Bursa Malaysia KLCI fell 0.4 per cent.

ers have stopped arguing theology and started trading momentum. Asian equity markets leaned into the relief momentum."

He noted that South Korea, Taiwan and Japan are not debating whether AI destroys jobs. Instead, they are shipping the equipment that powers it, with capital expenditure on AI being their earnings, he said.

# Yen close to 2-week lows on rate concerns

THE yen hovered near two-week lows against the US dollar on Wednesday (Feb 25) after sliding the previous day on worries about a more dovish Bank of Japan (BOJ) and rising tensions with China, while investors focused on broader risk sentiment.

Japan's currency weakened on Tuesday after a report that Prime Minister Sanae Takaichi told the BOJ she had reservations about more interest rate hikes and in reaction to China putting more Japanese firms on an export control list in retaliation against Takaichi's comments about Taiwan.

Following Takaichi's landslide election win on Feb 8, the yen strengthened as markets bet that a government favouring fiscal stimulus would tilt the balance of risks towards additional monetary tight-

ening. The yen hovered around 156 against the dollar and was last at 156.10.

The government on Wednesday nominated two academics viewed as strong stimulus advocates to the central bank's board, a move that could push the BOJ in an even more dovish direction, although Derek Halpenny, head of research global markets at MUFG, voiced some uncertainty on that point.

"We can't be sure this will change the policy board dramatically especially given the two departing members were on the dovish side," he said.

The US dollar index was down 0.1 per cent at 97.78. US President Donald Trump said little to allay concerns about the future of his tariffs and global trade policy in his State of the Union speech on Tues-

"The fundamental underpinning for our CNY appreciation view - a starting point of deep currency undervaluation and the remarkable strength of the export sector - remain very much in place," said analysts at Goldman Sachs.

"While uncertainties remain, we believe the likelihood of President Trump imposing additional Section 301 tariffs on Chinese products is low ahead of his planned visit to China at the end of March."

The New Zealand dollar inched higher to US\$0.5983, while China's yuan extended Tuesday's sharp gains to touch an almost three-year peak of 6.8703. China is closely monitoring US policies and says it will decide "in due course" whether to adjust countermeasures to US tariffs. REUTERS

day. The Australian dollar rose 0.55 per cent to US\$0.7097 after a pickup in inflation raised the risk of rate hikes. The Aussie is a so-called high-beta currency with a strong and persistent correlation

with global risk assets, especially equities, and it remains the most vulnerable to stock market turmoil being in a particularly stretched overbought position.

The euro was up 0.15 per cent

against the dollar at US\$1.1792.

The yuan, which has gained nearly 7 per cent in 10 months, hits 6.8766 to the dollar on Tuesday, its highest in almost three years, and held at 6.8778 in offshore trade.
