Singapore shares rise, tracking regional gains; STI up 0.5%

Across the broader market, gainers beat losers 322 to 231, after 1.4b securities worth S\$1.4b change hands. BY BENJAMIN CHER

THE Straits Times Index (STI) advanced on Tuesday (Feb 18), mirroring regional indices.

The STI closed 0.5 per cent or 20.71 points higher at 3,925.56.

The index's top gainer was ST Engineering, up 2.2 per cent or S\$0.11 at S\$5.11.

Meanwhile, its biggest loser was Hongkong Land, falling 2.9 per cent or US\$0.13 to US\$4.36.

The trio of local banks ended higher on Tuesday. DBS rose 1.8 per cent or S\$0.80 to S\$45.80, OCBC was up 1 per cent or S\$0.18 at S\$17.76, and UOB closed 0.1 per cent or S\$0.04 higher at S\$38.65.

Sats and AEM got an uplift from being mentioned by Prime Minister Lawrence Wong during the Budget 2025 speech. Sats ticked up 1.8 per cent or S\$0.06 to S\$3.35, while AEM climbed 4.5 per cent or S\$0.07 to S\$1.61 by the end of trading on Tuesday.

Across the broader market, advancers

outnumbered decliners 322 to 231, after 1.4 billion securities worth S\$1.4 billion changed hands.

Major indices in the region also closed higher. Japan's Nikkei 225 rose 0.3 per cent, South Korea's Kospi was up 0.6 per cent, Hong Kong's Hang Seng gained 1.6 per cent, while the Bursa Malaysia Kuala Lumpur Composite Index ticked up 0.1 per cent.

The meeting on Monday between Chinese President Xi Jinping and business leaders, including those from the country's tech sector like Alibaba's Jack Ma and Huawei's Ren Zhengfei, could boost investor sentiment for Chinese stocks, according to a Maybank report on Tuesday.

Reducing unreasonable fines and levelling the competitive field for private companies were among the results of those discussions.

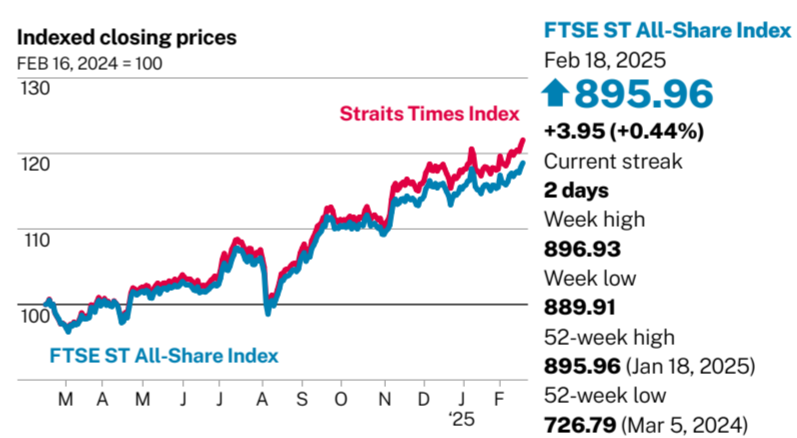

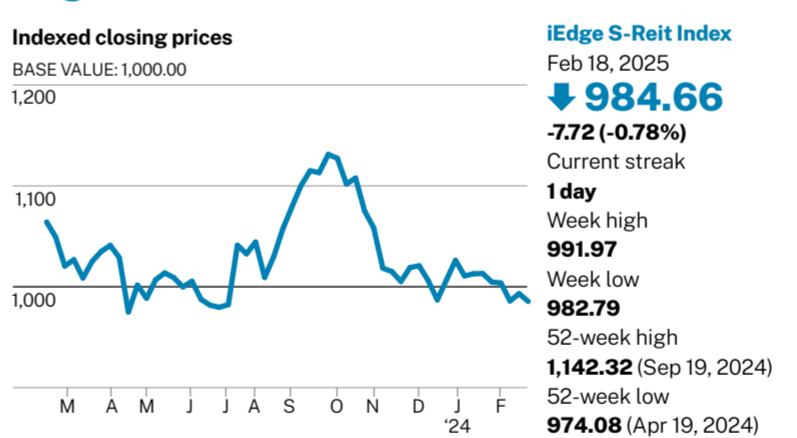

US dollar firms; Aussie steady after RBA rate cut

THE greenback firmed on Tuesday (Feb 18) as traders weighed tariff worries, geopolitical uncertainties and the path to US rate cuts, while the Australian dollar held near two-month highs after the Reserve Bank of Australia (RBA) cut rates but cautioned on further easing.

Traders eyed talks on Tuesday aimed at ending the Ukraine war, as US and Russian officials held more than four hours of talks in Saudi Arabia's capital Riyadh. Ukraine, which was not attending the talks, has said no peace deal can be made on its behalf. The euro was 0.26 per cent lower at US\$1.04535.

The single currency rose last week as optimism grew over prospects of a peace deal between Ukraine and Russia. It traded at its highest in more than two weeks on Friday at around US\$1.051. "Bar-

ring a major breakthrough, the optimistic push and relative upbeat risk sentiment may stall or fade in the next couple of days and the dollar can continue to recover some ground," said Francesco Pesole, foreign currency strategist at ING.

Sterling eased 0.27 per cent to US\$1.25925. Investor focus this week is also on Wednesday's release of minutes of the Federal Reserve's meeting in January that may show how policymakers have accounted for the risk of a broader tariff war resulting from President Donald Trump's trade policies. Data last week showed US consumer prices increased at the fastest pace in nearly 18 months in January, reinforcing the Fed's message that it was in no rush to resume cutting rates amid growing economic worries.



"Trade policy uncertainty is at a record high... and given that the labour market is solid, there is no compelling case to cut rates imminently," ANZ strategists said in a note.

ANZ now expects rate cuts to resume in the second half of 2025, with a further 75 basis points of easing anticipated. Markets though are pricing in only 40 bps of cuts for this year.

Swaps imply just a 20 per cent probability for a follow-up cut in April, although a move in May is still almost fully priced in.

Kerry Craig, global market strategist at JPMorgan Asset Management, said the RBA's move looks more like an "insurance" cut, which keeps it in step with global central banks, rather than the start of an aggressive easing cycle.

Elsewhere, the yen was on the back foot after its recent gains as strong growth data bolstered odds of the Bank of Japan raising interest rates again this year, with July seen as a live meeting.

The yen was last at 151.84 to the dollar, down around 0.2 per cent on the day. It is up 3.5 per cent against the greenback so far in 2025. REUTERS
